

TGCU Rally Host Duty Reminders

- Coordinate plans together with rally host team; first couple listed is team leader.
- If an appointed team member is unable to participate, it is his responsibility to find a replacement & communicate that change to the host team leader at least two weeks prior to the event.
- Plan activities & meals for Thursday evening through Sunday morning.
- Send rally schedule to Debra, to post in newsletter (by 25th of month prior to rally, i.e. **Feb. 25** for March 9-12 rally).
- Shop for food & decorating items needed, keeping receipts (reimbursable any time during the rally); check boxes in store room first for available décor—food & decorating budget for each rally is typically \$300 for 40-50 in attendance. [Saturday breakfast is pre-planned & not included in team responsibilities or expenses.]
- Check supplies on hand in clubhouse before ordering more. Decorate accordingly.
- Make coffee each morning; prepare and serve meals; remember to plan in advance to have propane turned on if oven is to be used.
- Post daily activities on clubhouse whiteboard.
- For each event, make sure kitchen is clean & restrooms supplied.
- Set up tables & chairs for meals, TGCU meeting & Sunday Devotional.
- Ask someone to lead in prayer before each meal.
- Make announcements & remind members of Sunday Service, informing them that our collections always go to the Zavalla Food Pantry.
- Clean up after each meal.
- Take trash to dumpster as needed.
- Turn off lights after each event **OR** arrange for those remaining later to do so.

It seems like forever since we've had a rally at TAHI ...but February 17th will be here before you know it. We hope to get back on track after having to cancel gatherings in January because of several people having Covid. In fact, February will be moving very quickly for several TAHI residents as they (we) travel to Galveston, Texas on the ninth of February to participate in and enjoy the Galveston Mardi Gras celebration. We will be part of a total 96 Airstream trailers & motor homes as we park downtown along the parade route (real up close and personal) ..isn't it great to be an Airstreamer!



Since December we have had several people make application to become members of Texas Airstream Harbor with three wishing to purchase a lot and/or cabanas. With new rules of vetting prospective new members, vetting will take place as prospective members attend a rally. Since the rally in January was cancelled two were not able to be vetted. However, they are scheduled for February.

Board members have yet to be named directors of several areas of responsibility (also because of no meeting in January,) but will be filled in February so that members will know who to contact for certain needs in the park. And, as always, members are asked to participate in helping those directors and attend Work Days when announced. Thank you for placing your trust in these elected board members to make decisions to maintain and manage the parks day to day business.

Wet, cold weather and Covid has suspended the start up of the new sewer plant. Following a start up run we were operating both plants at the same time causing an overload of the fuse that protects our circuits. A new fuse at a cost of about \$3.00 was installed, but recommendations from our electrician to move some power lines to help avoid a repeat of the blown fuse has been delayed because he has been at home with Covid.

As soon as our roads dry out and the weather warms up I will be calling for a Work Day to patch some pot holes that have developed. We will need as many workers as possible to clean, fill holes with rock and asphalt and tamp as smooth as possible.

Annual TAHI assessments have been coming in since the start of our fiscal year in December. Our treasurer tells me that all assessments have been paid, files for taxes gathered and returned to our CPA to take care of our obligations with the IRS. RutheAnn, with help from Mary Watermann previous treasurer, worked very hard to arrange the paper work required by the CPA.

The TAHI water plant has received good reviews from testing and lab reports. We are blessed to have these water resources available to us as we learn of a lot of water woes of our neighbors in Zavalla. However, we are experiencing some well pump controller issues but constant inspections and corrections by Carl Pennington, Gil Moll, Charlie Petrillo, Bill Pearson and yours truly until our electrician can install a new controller. Delayed because of Covid.
