
Mother nature dealt us a "downturn" with a lot of rain early on in the sum-



mer and managed to raise the lake level about 6 feet over-full while storms blew over some oak and pine trees near the lake area. A tree cutting crew was brought in to clear away three huge oak trees on Dogwood and a couple of big old pines in front of the Loveladys and Decuirs lots on Angelina. Those trees were in our mowing permit area.

In other news: ... Board member Jim Hodges contracted with Trust Foundation company

to repair the clubhouse foundation that had settled several inches over the years. Near the patio side of the clubhouse the floor was raised up almost 7 inches and the flooring near the library was also brought back up to level...They did an excellent job. All done within the budget approved by the membership this past May.



During the summer, the TCEQ granted all of our exceptions to get well number 3 in service. We still have not been given the go ahead permit to operate well 3, but we are getting very close. All easements have been

signed, all laboratory tests passed, well pump tests passed and the remaining order from TCEQ is to build a security fence around the well head and controls. That fence will be constructed with the fencing that is currently being removed from around the old sewer plant.

Our insurance folks came out and did some inspections to our clubhouse which resulted in our renewing all our fire extinguishers and to place 4 smoke alarms through out the clubhouse. Charlie Petrillo helped with the extiguishers while Rick Nelson and Jack Stewart put up the smoke detectors. Thanks men..
