Greetings Caravanners,

Welcome to the Ores, Shores, Waters, and Lights – East, N-46-L, 2017, Caravan. Our roster is full. Enclosed you will find an updated list of your fellow caravanners. Please review your data on the roster and ensure that all fields are complete, including your Good Sam number (GS#), if you have one. If you discover an inaccuracy, please email or call us, ASAP so we can correct it. If you both have cell phones, please provide both numbers and indicate who belongs to each.

Please send your final payment of \$1,300.00, by **April 1<sup>st</sup>**, made out to Chip DeLeeuw, to the address listed above. **Important: Please include a completed copy of your "data sheet, including a brief bio, with your payment."**

We will rendezvous at Indian Lake State Park on Sunday, July 30, 2017, at 4:30 pm in the campground "Beach Shelter." (8970 W. County Rd. 442, Manistique, MI 49854, 906-341-2355). Please plan to arrive by 3 p.m. so that you can be set-up prior to the 4:30 p.m. social hour, orientation, and dinner. Note: This campground is electric only, please arrive prepared. A dump station and potable water is available, along with very nice bathrooms and showers.

Early parking is available (NOT included in the caravan fee), but you must call the campground phone number above, in advance, to make your reservations. Identify yourself as part of the caravan group. You may be assigned a different area and be moved to our location on the scheduled parking date.

Enclosed, is a **Medical Alert Form**. Please fill it out, place it in a sealed envelope with your name on the outside, and **bring it with you to the rendezvous**. You will receive your Drivers Manual when we receive your sealed Medical Alert Form.

In the event of an emergency at home, we have provided a list of our camping locations and contact information along with the phone number for the Michigan State Police. Please leave a copy of the emergency communication information with your home point of contact. A last resort would be for your home point of contact to call the caravan leaders.

A few brief comments about the theme portions of our caravan:

**ORES:** We will take a guided tour of the Fayette Historic Town site (an exceptionally well preserved iron smelting company town) and a boat tour through the Soo Locks. An average of 80 million tons of cargo move through the locks each year including Upper Peninsula iron, which is valued at \$500.4 billion.

**SHORES:** We will travel and camp along the shoreline of three of the five Great Lakes (Huron, Michigan, and Superior).

**WATERS:** We have identified and selected 15 different waterfalls for caravanners to view; some can be viewed from your vehicles, most require a short and easy walk, and a couple will require a moderate walk.

**LIGHTS:** There is at least one lighthouse open for tours at each stop on this caravan.

Mackinac, or, Mackinaw, regardless of how it's spelled, it's pronounced "Mack-i-naw," never "Mack-i-nack."

In the Upper Peninsula, bugs can be extreme. Spring through July is when the mosquitos and black flies are most abundant. Deer flies come out during hot, dry weather and stable flies come out during hot, moist weather when there is an off-shore breeze. Bug problems should be past their peak while we are on this caravan. However, please come prepared with bug spray.

We recommend you dress in layers. Temperatures can be cooler on/near the water. Rain gear is advised.

Lake Superior shorelines are excellent locations for finding agates and the Whitefish Point Bird Observatory is ranked among the most significant avian migration sites in North America. If you have experience as a Bird Watcher or Rock Hound, and would be willing to share insights with those of us who have interest and limited knowledge, please let us know.

Please notify us immediately if you need to cancel for medical emergency reasons. Refunds after April 1, 2017 are at leader discretion.

**Action Items:**

- Send in completed data sheet, including short bio. Due April 1, 2017.

- Please bring this general information packet with you, to be placed in your Driver's Manual.
