Leave Zavalla on April 14(?). Depending on the group, we can leave before or after church.

Drive 4 hrs 14 minutes... 245 miles.

First night at Chem-a-haut State Park outside of Bastrop, LA. 888-677-2436 318-283-0812 \$16 for Water and Elec

Drive 6 hours 31 mins 331 miles.

Night 2 (April 15) at Elliott Creek (Slickrock) near Russellville, Alabama. \$15 1111 CR 88 Russellville, Alabama 256-332-4392 877-367-2232

Drive 1 hour 25 minutes.

Nights 3 & 4 (April 16 & 17) Monte Sano State Park in Huntsville, ALA. Tour Space Center and Museums and Wal-mart. 256-534-6589. There is a park next to the space center but we will be there during space camp for the kiddies. \$19 a night plus 3.09 tax. 58 spaces available with water and electric. 5 minutes from Huntsville.

Drive 4 hours 34 minutes, 252 miles People who want to tour Gatlinburg should leave early like at 6 AM or earlier. For those of us not interested in touring Gatlinburg, we can leave at a more normal time like 8 AM not that 8 AM is so normal and join those hardy folks for dinner.

Night 5 (April 18) in Sevierville, TN. 15 miles north of Gatlinburg and \$20 cheaper. We could stay 2 nights if people want to shop or do more in Gatlinburg. We need to decide so we can make reservations but I am going with 1 night.

Drive 5 hours, 322 miles to Staunton, VA.

Night 6 (April 19) Staunton, VA. Get up the next morning and tour Woodrow Wilson Presidential Library and maybe Luray Caverns.

Drive 2 hrs 9 mins 125 miles to Harpers Ferry KOA, WV

Nights 7, 8, 9 (April 20 - 21) at KOA in Harpers Ferry, WV We could cut this to 2 nights. Tour the town the day we get there and the Battleground the next day. Estimated cost \$103 minus \$8.50 if you have the KOA Value Kard (cost \$24 a year).

Drive 1 hour 36 minutes ---85 miles to 5381 Sands Road, Lothian, MD Duncan's Family Campground.

Nights 10, 11, 12, 13 (April 22 - 25) We could extend this to 5 or 6 nights depending on pissed we are with each other. Duncan's gives a 15% discount to the over 65 crowd and 10% to AAA, Good Sam, FMC, etc. Full Hook-ups are \$45 a night less your discount. About \$38 is a great rate for DC. There are shuttles to the Metro but we can also drive about 15 minutes and be at the Suitland Metro Station. We can decide on what we want to see after we decide on how long to stay in each of these places.
