TGCU Rally Host Duty Reminders

- Coordinate plans together with rally host team. First names listed are head hosts.
- If you are unable to host, it's your responsibility to find someone to trade months with and communicate this to the head hosts at least two weeks prior to the rally.
- Plan activities & meals for Thursday through Sunday morning.
- Send rally schedule to Gina to post in newsletter by the 25th of the prior month (i.e. January 25th for the February rally)
- Shop for food & decorations needed, keeping receipts (reimbursable during the rally)- check boxes in storage room for available decorations before purchasing new items. Decorate accordingly.
- Post daily activities on clubhouse white board.
- Make coffee each morning, prepare and serve meals, and remember to plan in advance to have propane turned on if oven is to be used.
- Before each rally, make sure restrooms are supplied and clean.
- Set up tables and chairs for meals, TGCU and TAHI meetings, and Sunday devotional.
- Ask someone to lead in prayer before each meal.
- Make announcements & remind everyone of Sunday service, informing them that our collections always go to the Zavalla Food Pantry.
- Clean up after each meal, paying close attention that the kitchen is cleaned and all trash is taken to the dumpster.
- Turn off lights after each event or arrange for those remaining later to do so.

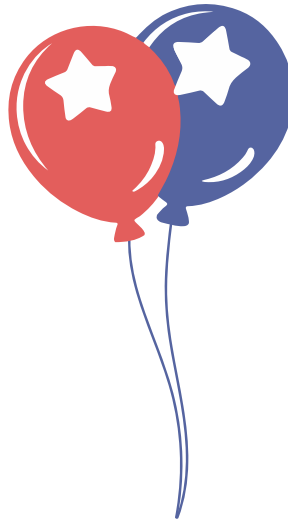

3. Join Your Community.

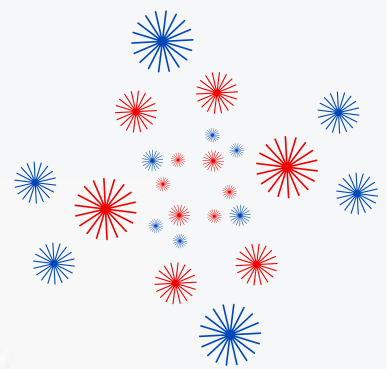
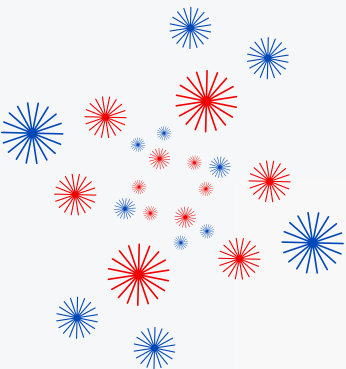
