*Students will be separated according to individual ability level, size, speed, strength, and experience according to instructor's discretion.

Closures due to major holidays, major storms, power outages, & alike will not be made up as they are not the fault of the dojo. Our dojo staff is very generous with extra training opportunities throughout the year; however, TKC may exercise the right to close for up to THREE, 1-week periods during the year for management determined reasons. As learned from the COVID-19 pandemic, we can be very flexible to accommodate most situations.

Karate instruction is, first and foremost, for the student and not for entertainment or abusive purposes. TKC management reserves the exclusive right of expulsion to any student and/or parent/guardian who engage in dangerous/harmful, or unlawful, or divisive words/actions/deeds (as determined by TKC management/ownership). TKC strives to always provide a safe, nurturing learning environment to all who enroll with good intentions.

TKC Dojo accepts these instruments of payment of tuition: EFT from bank checking or savings accounts and all major credit/debit cards *except AMEX. Cash or checks are accepted only for paid in full tuition payments. Additional purchases and/or other expenses may not be added to tuition due to contract stipulations. We accept cash, check, credit/debit cards (NOT AMEX) as well as VENMO, Zelle, and money orders. TKC Dojo makes every effort to keep costs affordable; however, with inflation and other rising cost factors, rates must inevitably increase. We make every effort to minimize the economic impact on our dojo families.

Developmental Program Exams for NINJA & SAMURAI Students: Advancement is offered quarterly to pre-qualified students predicated on attendance, attitude, and athletic effort. Rank is only in-house promotion within our developmental karatedo curriculum and not purely by IKGA standards. Promotion results are given in charge of belt and certificate process and ceremony.

IKGA Karatedo Exams: Sub-Black Belt ('Mudansha') exams are offered quarterly as announced for White through Orange Belts. Exams for Green, Blue, Brown Belts are only offered in June & December. Students who pass are awarded a new belt & promotion certificate and worldwide recognition within our IKGA network.

Black Belt ('Yudansha') exams are offered in June and December within TKC or at IKGA major events like IKGA international seminars; Dan grading fees, licenses, and custom belts are additional charges - please inquire.

Uniforms & Kumite Safety Gear: All gear must meet the approval of management for safety reasons. Generic and competition certified gear options are available; however, certified gear is recommended to avoid having to re-purchase compliant, competition gear. *ALL gear and uniforms must be purchased through TKC Dojo - not independently.

All membership contracts will be enforced until their end dates - NO exceptions. Moving out of state, with sufficient notice and documentation of confirmation, **may be** acceptable grounds to terminate a membership contract. TKC management maintains the sole discretion in deciding this matter; all decisions are final.

Vacations, "taking a break", or other discretionary absences, will not void, alter, or "freeze" tuition payments in a membership contract. All memberships are mutually agreed upon contracts . Exception: TKC will add-on/credit a maximum of one calendar months' worth of non-chargeable lessons. This one-month extension must be claimed/used within 6 months of your contract's termination date. To earn this credit: NO classes, NO team training sessions, NO competitions, NO coaching, NO private lessons, may have taken place for an entire calendar month (day #1 through the last day of that month inclusively).
