On 09/03/2023 at about 1643 hours, 7b 7b called Pencom to report a disturbance at 102 S. Maple Ln. in Port Angeles. 7b advised Pencom that a red Chevrolet Tahoe was blocking the roadway when the Suspect driving the Tahoe struck somebody with their vehicle. Pencom advised that they could still hear a verbal disturbance in progress. Sgt. Keegan, Deputy Middlekauff and I responded to the scene utilizing our overhead emergency lights and audible siren.

I had already responded to this scene earlier in the day regarding an ongoing civil dispute between the driver of the Tahoe, Thomas E. Cline DOB:02/10/1963, and people visiting the nearby Motorcycle track. At that time Thomas was upset that visitors to the track were using the private roadway to access the track with their large trailers. At that time, Thomas was blocking the roadway with his vehicle, A red 2000 Chevrolet Tahoe bearing Washington registration 653ZKY, and a sign at S Maple Lane and S Hemlock Lane.

Upon arrival at the scene at about 1652 hours, I saw Cline sitting in his vehicle and a male standing near a white pickup, later identified as 7b Witness Victim. I approached the group around the white pickup and asked who was stuck by the vehicle. The parties there indicated that 7b had been struck by Cline's vehicle while he was operating it and believed it was intentional. I contacted Cline, asked him to step out of the vehicle and advised him that he was not under arrest but was being detained. I detained Cline in two sets of wrist restraints behind his back and advised him of his Miranda warning. Cline said he understood his rights and was willing to speak with me. The following is a summarization of what Cline told me:

- He had been blocking the roadway because he was upset about people using Maple Ln. to access the motorcycle track.
- The HOA has a long-standing easement agreement with the owner of the motorcycle track for

NARRATIVE

INVESTIGATIVE REPORT BY DEPUTY CODY BROOKS C143

INVESTIGATION:

On 09/03/2023 at about 1643 hours, 7b called Pencom to report a disturbance at 102 S. Maple Ln. in Port Angeles. 7b advised Pencom that a red Chevrolet Tahoe was blocking the roadway when the suspect driving the Tahoe struck somebody with their vehicle. Pencom advised that they could still hear a verbal disturbance in progress. Sgt. Keegan, Deputy Middlekauff, and I responded to the scene utilizing our overhead emergency lights and audible siren.

I had already responded to this scene earlier in the day regarding an ongoing civil dispute between the driver of the Tahoe, Thomas E. Cline DOB:02/10/1963, and people visiting the nearby Motorcycle track. At that time Thomas was upset that visitors to the track were using the private roadway to access the track with their large trailers. At that time, Thomas was blocking the roadway with his vehicle, A red 2000 Chevrolet Tahoe bearing Washington registration 653ZKY, and a sign at S Maple Lane and S Hemlock Lane.

Upon arrival at the scene at about 1652 hours, I saw Cline sitting in his vehicle and a male standing near a white pickup, later identified as 7b Witness Victim. There were multiple people standing near the pickup at the time. I approached the group around the white pickup and asked who was stuck by the vehicle. The parties there indicated that 7b had been struck by Cline's vehicle while he was operating it and believed it was intentional. I contacted Cline, asked him to step out of the vehicle and advised him that he was not under arrest but was being detained. I detained Cline in two sets of wrist restraints behind his back and advised him of his Miranda warning. Cline said he understood his rights and was willing to speak with me. A short time later Cline began experiencing a cramp in his shoulder, so I removed his restraints and re-applied a single set of handcuffs in front of him. The following is a summarization of what Cline told me:

SUSPECT STATEMENT: THOMAS CLINE, 09/03/2023, 103 S. MAPLE LN.:

- He had been blocking the roadway because he was upset about people using Maple Ln. to access the motorcycle track.
- He was the Vice President of the Homeowners Association (HOA) for the community.
- The HOA has a long-standing easement agreement with the owner of the motorcycle track for people visiting the track to access the track using Whispering Firs Estates Drive instead of S Maple Lane.
- He was out blocking the roadway when 7b approached in his pickup and Cline refused him access which led to a verbal argument.
- walked into the roadway and grabbed Cline's Road sign which was posted directly in front of Cline's vehicle.
- Cline stated he hit the brakes and didn't believe that he struck Snider.
- moved briefly so Cline decided to try and block the vehicle again and tried to pull around Snider.
- jumped in front of Cline's vehicle again, so Cline hit the brakes, he again stated he didn't believe he struck Snider.

NARRATIVE (Continuation)

I asked Cline's if he ever hit his accelerator pedal while was directly in front of his vehicle and he said, "Well yes, but not hard."

I asked Cline why he would accelerate towards Snider, and he said he wanted him to move.

INVESTIGATION CONTINUED:

I made contact with Deputy Middlekauff who had taken statements from 7b and other witnesses. I advised Deputy Middlekauff of Cline's account. Deputy Middlekauff advised that 7b had a similar account and stated he was struck twice by the vehicle. Deputy Middlekauff told me that 7b said he wanted to press charges multiple times. Deputy Middlekauff advised me that there was a video recording of the incident in which she could see Cline strike 7b in what appeared to be an intentional act. I re-contacted Cline and asked him if there was anything he would like to change in his statement now knowing there was a video recording of the incident. Cline said he did not want to change his statement.

I briefed Sgt. Keegan of the information provided by both parties and advised that I had developed probable cause for the arrest of Cline. Sgt. Keegan advised that a summons to court appeared appropriate to separate the involved parties for the night. I advised Cline that he was under arrest for assault, and he later agreed to go home for the evening and no longer block the roadway. At about 1720 hours, Sgt. Keegan removed Cline from wrist restraints and Cline left the scene a short time later. See Deputy Middlekauff's and Sgt. Keegan's reports for further details.

Based on the investigation I have developed probable cause to believe that Thomas E. Cline DOB:02/10/1963, committed the crime of Assault in the 3rd degree when he negligently used his motor vehicle, as a weapon or instrument, to cause bodily harm.

NARRATIVE

On 09-03-2023 at around 1643 hours Deputies Brooks, Middlekauff and I were dispatched to a series of disturbances which led to an assault at the intersection of South Maple Ln and South Hemlock Ln in Four Season's Park involving Thomas Cline blocking the private roadway with his vehicle.

The first disturbance was handled by Deputy Middlekauff, who after a short time on scene had to be rerouted to a trespass in progress. I assisted Deputy Middlekauff at the trespass, and she informed me of what was going on in Four Seasons Park. She also mentioned that due to the road being blocked, she had to drive off the road to get around Cline's roadblock.

At the prior disturbance we contacted the homeowner's association vice-president Thomas Cline. Cline had blocked South Maple Ln with his vehicle and a sign stating that S. Maple Ln was a private road and only open to residents and their guests. Cline stated that he was doing this at the HOA's request as the vehicles associated with the motor cross track are damaging the neighborhood's private roads. Cline said that S. Hemlock is an easement between the track and the neighborhood and that they want the motor cross traffic to stay on S. Hemlock. Cline stated that the HOA has an attorney working on litigating the easement issue, and that they informed him that what he was doing was legal.

However, during this interaction Cline was also blocking access to residents who live on S. Hemlock. The resident who lives at the corner of the intersection was also complaining about Cline's roadblock being in front of his house. During the interaction between Cline and this resident Cline stated that the HOA had a vote and decided to block the road. It was also brought up that the "detour" that Cline was having people travel would be dangerous for larger trailers and RVs. Cline also told me that he was upset because he heard that the motor cross track is telling people to drive on Maple.

Prior to leaving, I told Cline that he has to allow for emergency vehicles and suggested that he allow the larger vehicles through the roadblock for safety reasons.

We were called back a short time later due to a disturbance escalating to an assault. When we arrived, Deputy Brooks contacted Cline and Deputy Middlekauff contacted the victim and witness. As a crowd started to gather involving upset residents and individuals associated with the motor cross I acted as security and crowd control.

After awhile I was informed by Deputy Middlekauff that the victim moved Cline's sign, drove past where the sign was, then while standing in front of Cline's vehicle waved his mother (who was in a separate vehicle) through. While doing so, Cline used his vehicle to hit the victim with his SUV twice. I was also informed that there was video of the incident.

I contacted the victim away from the crowd. I asked him what he wanted us to do. He told me that he just wanted Cline to get his vehicle off the road. I contacted Cline. I explained to Cline that I understand that it was a private road, and technically the individual who moved the sign may have been considered to have been trespassing; however, using his car to hit him was not reasonable force and is considered assault. I explained to Cline that we could arrest him for assault or, if he agrees to stop his efforts to block the road and leave, we would refer him to the Prosecutor for charging later. Cline agreed to go home.

While leaving the area, I was contacted by some of the neighborhood residents who were upset that Cline was blocking the road.

NARRATIVE

SUPPLEMENTAL REPORT BY DEPUTY MIDDLEKAUFF

INVESTIGATION: On 09-02-2023 at about 1645 hours, I was dispatched to an assault at 102 S Maple Lane in Port Angeles, WA. Pencom told responding deputies that involved parties were not separated and were yelling at each other. Sergeant Keegan, Deputy Brooks, and I responded to the scene with emergency lights and sirens activated. I arrived and contacted the victim, 7b 7b initially told me that his body had been struck by a vehicle.

VICTIM PARTY STATEMENT by 7b Witness Victim

- stated he was leaving the motorcycle track and intended on turning northbound on S Maple Lane but there was a sign and a red truck blocking the roadway.
- parked his vehicle and got out to move the sign out of the roadway.
- The then directed his friend's mom, The Witness to drive around the red truck.
- The driver of the red truck, identified as Tom Kline, yelled at 7b about not being able to drive on a private road.
- At the time, Kline's vehicle was parked so stood in front of the vehicle so could drive her vehicle next to Snider.
- Kline started to accelerate his vehicle forward and struck 76 in the stomach with the front of his vehicle.
- stated Kline was aware he had hit him with his vehicle because Kline told him to get out of the roadway from inside his vehicle.
- stated he was struck by Kline's vehicle twice in the stomach and left hip area.
- Kline then stopped his vehicle and got out of the vehicle to confront Snider.
- and Kline yelled at each other then separated and waited for law enforcement to arrive.

I took photographs of 7b s stomach and hip area where he was struck by the vehicle. I did not observe any marks. I spoke with 7b s juvenile sons, 7c c and 7c. 7c Chand 7c t confirmed 7b s statement.

I spoke with 7b 7b Witness. 7b Witness stated she saw Kline strike 7b two separate times with the vehicle.

7b Witness watched the incident occur from about 30 feet away.

The following is a summarization of his statement: WITNESS PARTY STATEMENT by 7b Witness: 7b lives at 7b Witness Victim at the intersection of S Maple Ln and S Hemlock Ln. was inside his residence when he heard yelling outside. went outside and saw 7b standing in the street in front of Kline's vehicle. He saw Kline in the driver seat and Kline accelerated the vehicle and struck 7b twice. said he heard Kline yell, "that's what you get for standing in front of my car" after hitting with his vehicle. Kline exited his vehicle and Kline and vehicle and kline and vehicle are detailed at each other inches away from each other. Kline and 7b separated and waited for law enforcement to arrive. See Deputy Brooks' report for Kline's statement. Sergeant Keegan, Deputy Brooks, and I had responded to the same location earlier in the day involving another dispute involving Tom Kline (CCSO #2023-17526). At that call for service, told me that Kline had jumped in front of a vehicle to prevent them from driving on S Maple Lane.
