I, **Seth Parker**, am a law enforcement officer for the Clallam County Sheriff's Office. Based upon the following narrative, I believe there is probable cause the person arrested has committed the aforementioned crime(s).

NARRATIVE

On 09/29/22, at approximately 1811 hours, I was dispatched to an assault at 93 S. Alder Ln, in Clallam County, Washington. PENCOR had received a call from [7b] [7b] who reported witnessing two males assault another male and had him on the ground kicking him in the face before everyone separated back to their own property.

Sgt. Knutson and I arrived on scene and contacted the involved individuals: [7b Witness Victim], Tung (Tommy) Vo (DOB 11/20/82), and Brady Bedell (DOB 12/23/79). We also interviewed several witnesses who said they were present during the assault.

The incident initially started over a disputed property line and a fence Brady was starting to build on the disputed line. [7] is a board member for the neighborhood HOA and deals with their roadway issues. [7] had come over to the address to discuss the issue with [7b Witness] (the owner of 93 S. Alder Ln) in the driveway. While he was talking with her, Brady verbally confronted [7] about the fence.

Tommy, who lives down the street, came up to support Brady and was arguing about the fence with [7] when the altercation occurred. Tommy stated it was [7] who tackled him to the ground and he had to fight to defend himself. A friend of Tommy's, Bradley, said he witnessed [7] tried to punch Tommy before [7] took him to the ground. Brady stated he had to pull [7] off of Tommy when he tackled him to the ground. The statements provided by Tommy, Brady, and [7b] were very vague and there were indicators they were intoxicated when we interviewed them.

[7] stated the altercation occurred when he was talking with Brady and Tommy approached them and started interjecting, so [7] told him he did not care what Tommy had to say. Tommy became confrontational and punched [7] in the side of the face and then tried to swing at him again. [7] and Tommy ended up on the ground. [7] and witnesses stated Tommy and Brady started kicking [7] in the head, his neck, and his sides repeatedly while [7] is on the ground.

[7] was treated by EMS on scene because he had several small lacerations on the sides of his face and his nose appeared swollen. [7] had numerous scraps on both his forearms, which he said occurred

I, **Seth Parker**, am a law enforcement officer for the Clallam County Sheriff's Office. Based upon the following narrative, I believe there is probable cause the person arrested has committed the aforementioned crime(s).

NARRATIVE

when he was on the ground getting kicked. [7] said he was face down and kept trying get his arms under himself to get up but they would not let him. [7] said he had a lot of soreness in his neck and he initially thought his nose might be broken but did not believe so now.

Based on the investigation, we determined Tommy was the primary aggressor and instigator in the physical altercation based on several witnesses who were present. [7] initially told me he took Tommy to the ground after he was punched and was fearful of being hit again; however, his written statement was not consistent with this, saying Tommy took him to the ground. Tommy and Brady's statements were very vague and were inconsistent with the amount of injuries [7] sustained. Brady denied assaulting Tom. Witnesses also described Brady repeatedly kicking [7] while he was on the ground along with Tommy and it was not in self-defense.

Therefore, based on the above information, I have probable cause to arrest Brady Bedell for Assault 4th Degree per RCW 9A.36.041.2.

Brady was advised of the above charge and released.

NARRATIVE

CASE REPORT: DEPUTY SETH PARKER #C134

INVESTIGATION:

On 09/29/22, at approximately 1811 hours, I was dispatched to an assault at 93 S. Alder Ln, in Clallam County, Washington. PENCOM had received a call from [7b] [7b] who reported witnessing two males assault another male and had him on the ground kicking him in the face before everyone separated back to their own property.

I arrived on scene and observed several people standing in the street near the address. I was immediately contacted by [7b] [7b] who informed me she was the President of the Home Owner's Association in Four Seasons Park, and started talking about an ongoing property line dispute between the owner of 93 S. Alder Ln and 111 S Alder Ln. I asked [7b] where the primary individuals who were involved were located. [7b] pointed to two men further down the street who she said assaulted "[7b]". Per Theresa, argument and altercation had occurred at the end of the driveway for 93 S. Alder Ln.

One of the males [7b] pointed at walked over to speak with me and identified himself as Tung Vo (DOB 11/20/82). Tung (Tommy) provided a verbal and written statement, the follow is a summary.

Statement by Tommy Vo: given on 09/29/22

- Tommy lives at 63 S. Alder place and heard an argument occurring at his neighbor's place (Brady Bedell).
- Tommy went down to see what was going on and "some guy" ([7b Witness]) was arguing with Brady.
- Tommy described [7b] as being in Brady's face yelling about the property line dispute between Brady's place and 93 S. Alder Ln.
- Tommy tried to stop the argument between [7b] and Brady when [7b] turned and pushed Tommy to the ground.
- Tommy said it happened very fast and he was trying to kick his way free from [7b] because [7b] had him down on the ground.
- Tommy said Brady helped pull [7b] off of him, which allowed him to get away.

While Tommy was speaking with me, I could smell an odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage about his person and his eyes were glossy. Tommy did have a small red [7b] over his left eye and a scratch on his left eyelid. Tommy later allowed me to take photographs of him and these marks. Tommy told me he wanted to press charges against [7b] for assaulting him.

A friend of Tommy's, [7b] Whyte-Simpson, was standing nearby and said he witnessed the altercation as well. [7b] provided a verbal and written statement, the following is a summary.

Statement by [7b] Whyte-Simpson: given on 09/29/22

- 7b saw the "bigger guy" (Thomas) try and swing on Tommy.
- 7b then threw his papers down and started to push Tommy down and was hitting him.
- Tommy defended himself and Brady pulled 7b off of Tommy.
- 7b then went after Tommy a second time and Tommy had to defend himself again.

Alder Ln. who was standing in the driveway when I arrived. was only able to provide a short statement because she had to take a family member to the hospital (unrelated to the incident). was provided a written statement form, which she agreed to fill out and provide to me later to include with the case file.

Statement by 7b Witness 7b given on 09/29/22

- described an ongoing property line dispute with Brady, who lives at 111 S. Alder Ln.
- Brady has been working towards building a fence on the property line.
- Brady put a post in the ground, which believed was in violation of the roadway easement, so she notified Theresa.
- said 7b (who deals with the HOA roadway issues) came over to explain to Brady why he could not put the fence up where the post was located.
- Brady and 7b were verbally disputing this issue when their other neighbor, Tommy, walk up and started arguing with 7b too.
- Tommy then punched 7b in the face.
- Then next thing she knew, 7b was on the ground and Tommy and Brady were kicking him repeatedly.
- 7b Witness had her cell phone and thought she recorded a video of the assault but realized she did not press record because she was shaking to bad.

Another female, [7b] [7b], advised me she lives with [7b Witness] and also witnessed the altercation. [7b] did not provide a written statement but the following is a summary of what she reported.

Statement by [7b] [7b]: given on 09/29/22

- [7b] was sitting in her chair, located inside the residence at 93 S. Alder Ln., while looking out the front window where she can see the end of the driveway.
- [7b] saw [7b] and [7b] standing on the right side of the driveway and [7b] and Tommy were on the left side out in the street.
- [7b] saw Tommy punch [7b] in the face and then they disappeared behind the brush on the left side of the driveway.
- [7b] was not able to see what happened once they moved behind the brush.

After EMS had evaluated [7b] I spoke with him about what occurred. [7b] provided a verbal and written statement about what occurred and the following is a summary.

Victim statement by [7b] [7b]: given on 09/29/22.

- [7b] ([7b]) had been made aware of the issues surrounding the fence and property line dispute and received a call from [7b] that Brady had put a post in the ground that was outside his property line.
- [7b] went over to 93 S. Alder Ln. to look at the situation when Brady came over from his house yelling at him that he could build the fence were he planned.
- [7b] tried to explain to Brady why he could not build there when Tommy arrived and started interjecting saying they could not do anything to stop it because they had checked with Code Enforcement.
- [7b] had been talking with Brady while Tommy was saying all of this and [7b] turned around telling Tommy he did not care.
- [7b] said Tommy got in his face and said, "You want to fight" then punch him in the side of the face.
- [7b] said this took him by surprise and the told Tommy he needed to leave but Tommy came towards him again saying, "so you do want to fight," then took another swing at [7b] (didn't make contact) and acted like it was going to try and hit him again.

- [7] said when he was on the ground, Tommy and Brady both started kicking him.
- [7] described Tommy as being the main one kicking him in the head, neck, and sides but saw Brady kicking him as well.
- [7] tried to get up several times but they kept pushing him down, punching and kicking him repeatedly.
- [7] said there were people there who witnessed it that were yelling at Tommy and Brady to stop, which they finally did and [7] was able to get up off the ground.
- [7] went to [7b] house to clean the blood off his face from his nose bleeding and the cuts on his arms.

INVESTIGATION CONTINUED:

[7] completed his written statement at his home where he allowed me to take photographs of his injuries. There were some small lacerations on the sides of his face and his nose appeared swollen. [7] had numerous scrapes on both his forearms, which he said occurred when he was on the ground getting kicked. [7] said he was face down and kept trying get his arms under himself to get up but they would not let him. [7] said he had a lot of soreness in his neck and he initially thought his nose might be broken but did not believe so now. [7] agreed to sign a medical records release form in case he requires medical care for injuries.

Based on the investigation, we determined Tommy was the primary aggressor and instigator in the physical altercation based on several witnesses. [7] initially told me he took Tommy to the ground after he was punched and was fearful of being hit again; however, his written statement was not consistent with this. Tommy and Brady's statements were very vague and were inconsistent with the amount of injuries [7] sustained. Witnesses also described Brady repeatedly kicking [7] while he was on the ground along with Tommy and it was not in self-defense. Brady also allowed me to take photographs of him and I observe redness and a small laceration on the back side of his right hand, over the knuckles.

Therefore, I have probable cause to arrest Tung (Tommy) Vo and Brady Bedell with Assault 4th Degree per RCW 9A.36.041.2.

Both Tommy and Brady were advised of the above charge, interviewed / released.

INVESTIGATION: On 09/29/2022 at 1818 hours, I arrived at 93 S. Alder Ln, Port Angeles, for the report of an assault.

Upon arriving, Deputy Parker was on scene and collecting statements from the victim and some of the witnesses. I saw a group of three males standing nearby and asked them if anyone was involved with the incident. One of the males, who identified himself as Brady V. Bedell, told me that he was involved. I collected a verbal statement from Bedell regarding the incident. The following is a paraphrased synopsis of Bedell's statement.

SUSPECT INTERVIEW WITH, Brady V. Bedell, 93 S. Alder Ln, Port Angeles, 09/29/2022, 1820 hours:

Bedell has property located at 111 S. Alder Ln. and is going through a property line dispute with the neighbors at 93 S. Alder Ln. Bedell was standing on his side of the property line when a guy (later identified as 7b 7b) got up to Bedell's face and was visibly shaking. Bedell said 7b was "nose to nose" with him talking about the by-laws/property line.

Bedell said he couldn't remember how the situation became physical, but at some point he pulled 7b off of his friend "Tommy" (Tung Vo- who lives immediately to the west of 93 S. Alder Ln.). Bedell said he never assaulted 7b during the incident.

INVESTIGATION: While interviewing Bedell, I smelled an odor of intoxicants emitting from his person. I asked Bedell to provide a written statement and he initially agreed to but turned it back to me after writing a few words. Bedell declined to write a statement.

I met with Deputy Parker who requested I interview 7b 7b President of the Home Owner's Association in Four Seasons Park. I met with 7b and obtained a verbal statement. Below is a paraphrased synopsis of 7b Witness statement to me. (Lehman later prepared a written statement which will be filed with CCSO records and included this case investigation.)

WITNESS INTERVIEW WITH, 7b 7b Witness 7b Witness Victim, Port Angeles, 09/29/2022, 1830 hours:

Prior to the assault incident, 7b received a call from a lady named "7" who lives at 7b Witness 7b told 7b about a property line dispute involving the neighboring resident (Bedell). 7b retrieved some maps (property) and met with another neighboring resident, 7b 7b, and provided the maps to him to assist with the property dispute.

7b and 7b walked over to 93 S. Alder Ln. 7b called the owner of the property at 111 S. Alder Ln (Brady's mother) to discuss the property line dispute. 7b had her back toward 93 S. Alder Ln while she was on the phone. 7b heard commotion behind her and when she turned around, the "oriental guy" (Tung Vo a.k.a. "Tommy") and Bedell were kicking and hitting 7b while 7b was on the ground. 7b attempted to get up a few times and Tommy and Bedell continued kicking and hitting 7b. 7b said Tommy was kicking 7b in the head. Neither Tommy nor Bedell were letting 7b get off the ground.

I had already responded to this scene earlier in the day regarding an ongoing civil dispute between the driver of the Tahoe, Thomas E. At that time Thomas was upset that visitors to the track were using the private roadway to access the track with their large trailers. At that time, Thomas was blocking the roadway with his vehicle, A red 2000 Chevrolet Tahoe bearing Washington registration 653ZKY, and a sign at S Maple Lane and S Hemlock Lane.

Upon arrival at the scene at about 1652 hours, I saw Cline sitting in his vehicle and a male standing near a white pickup, later identified as **7b** **7b Witness Victim**. I approached the group around the white pickup and asked who was stuck by the vehicle. The parties there indicated that **7b** had been struck by Cline's vehicle while he was operating it and believed it was intentional. I contacted Cline, asked him to step out of the vehicle and advised him that he was not under arrest but was being detained. I detained Cline in two sets of wrist restraints behind his back and advised him of his Miranda warning. Cline said he understood his rights and was willing to speak with me. The following is a summarization of what Cline told me:

- He had been blocking the roadway because he was upset about people using Maple Ln. to access the motorcycle track.

On 09/03/2023 at about 1643 hours, [7b] [7b] called Pencom to report a disturbance at 102 S. Maple Ln. in Port Angeles. [7b] advised Pencom that a red Chevrolet Tahoe was blocking the roadway when the suspect driving the Tahoe struck somebody with their vehicle. Pencom advised that they could still hear a verbal disturbance in progress. Sgt. Keegan, Deputy Middlekauff, and I responded to the scene utilizing our overhead emergency lights and audible siren.

I had already responded to this scene earlier in the day regarding an ongoing civil dispute between the driver of the Tahoe, Thomas E. Cline DOB:02/10/1963, and people visiting the nearby Motorcycle track. At that time Thomas was upset that visitors to the track were using the private roadway to access the track with their large trailers. At that time, Thomas was blocking the roadway with his vehicle, A red 2000 Chevrolet Tahoe bearing Washington registration 653ZKY, and a sign at S Maple Lane and S Hemlock Lane.

Upon arrival at the scene at about 1652 hours, I saw Cline sitting in his vehicle and a male standing near a white pickup, later identified as [7b Witness Victim]. There were multiple people standing near the pickup at the time. I approached the group around the white pickup and asked who was stuck by the vehicle. The parties there indicated that [7b] had been struck by Cline's vehicle while he was operating it and believed it was intentional. I contacted Cline, asked him to step out of the vehicle and advised him that he was not under arrest but was being detained. I detained Cline in two sets of wrist restraints behind his back and advised him of his Miranda warning. Cline said he understood his rights and was willing to speak with me. A short time later Cline began experiencing a cramp in his shoulder, so I removed his restraints and re-applied a single set of handcuffs in front of him. The following is a summarization of what Cline told me:

SUSPECT STATEMENT: THOMAS CLINE, 09/03/2023, 103 S. MAPLE LN.:

- He had been blocking the roadway because he was upset about people using Maple Ln. to access the motorcycle track.
- He was the Vice President of the Homeowners Association (HOA) for the community.
- The HOA has a long-standing easement agreement with the owner of the motorcycle track for people visiting the track to access the track using Whispering Firs Estates Drive instead of S Maple Lane.
- He was out blocking the roadway when [7b] approached in his pickup and Cline refused him access which led to a verbal argument.
- [7b] walked into the roadway and grabbed Cline's Road sign which was posted directly in front of Cline's vehicle.
- Cline stated he attempted to drive forward to block the vehicle as [7b] grabbed the sign, but [7b] jumped in front of his vehicle.
- Cline stated he hit the brakes and didn't believe that he struck Snider.
- [7b] moved briefly so Cline decided to try and block the vehicle again and tried to pull around Snider.
- [7b] jumped in front of Cline's vehicle again, so Cline hit the brakes, he again stated he didn't believe he struck Snider.

I asked Cline's if he ever hit his accelerator pedal while [7b] was directly in front of his vehicle and he said, "Well yes, but not hard."

I asked Cline why he would accelerate towards Snider, and he said he wanted him to move.

INVESTIGATION CONTINUED:

I made contact with Deputy Middlekauff who had taken statements from [7b] and other witnesses. I advised Deputy Middlekauff of Cline's account. Deputy Middlekauff advised that [7b] had a similar account and stated he was struck twice by the vehicle. Deputy Middlekauff told me that [7b] said he wanted to press charges multiple times. Deputy Middlekauff advised me that there was a video recording of the incident in which she could see Cline strike [7b] in what appeared to be an intentional act. I re-contacted Cline and asked him if there was anything he would like to change in his statement now knowing there was a video recording of the incident. Cline said he did not want to change his statement.

I briefed Sgt. Keegan of the information provided by both parties and advised that I had developed probable cause for the arrest of Cline. Sgt. Keegan advised that a summons to court appeared appropriate to separate the involved parties for the night. I advised Cline that he was under arrest for assault, and he later agreed to go home for the evening and no longer block the roadway. At about 1720 hours, Sgt. Keegan removed Cline from wrist restraints and Cline left the scene a short time later. See Deputy Middlekauff's and Sgt. Keegan's reports for further details.

Based on the investigation I have developed probable cause to believe that Thomas E. Cline DOB:02/10/1963, committed the crime of Assault in the 3rd degree when he negligently used his motor vehicle, as a weapon or instrument, to cause bodily harm.

NARRATIVE

On 09-03-2023 at around 1643 hours Deputies Brooks, Middlekauff and I were dispatched to a series of disturbances which led to an assault at the intersection of South Maple Ln and South Hemlock Ln in Four Season's Park involving Thomas Cline blocking the private roadway with his vehicle.

The first disturbance was handled by Deputy Middlekauff, who after a short time on scene had to be rerouted to a trespass in progress. I assisted Deputy Middlekauff at the trespass, and she informed me of what was going on in Four Seasons Park. She also mentioned that due to the road being blocked, she had to drive off the road to get around Cline's roadblock.

At the prior disturbance we contacted the homeowner's association vice-president Thomas Cline. Cline had blocked South Maple Ln with his vehicle and a sign stating that S. Maple Ln was a private road and only open to residents and their guests. Cline stated that he was doing this at the HOA's request as the vehicles associated with the motor cross track are damaging the neighborhood's private roads. Cline said that S. Hemlock is an easement between the track and the neighborhood and that they want the motor cross traffic to stay on S. Hemlock. Cline stated that the HOA has an attorney working on litigating the easement issue, and that they informed him that what he was doing was legal.

However, during this interaction Cline was also blocking access to residents who live on S. Hemlock. The resident who lives at the corner of the intersection was also complaining about Cline's roadblock being in front of his house. During the interaction between Cline and this resident Cline stated that the HOA had a vote and decided to block the road. It was also brought up that the "detour" that Cline was having people travel would be dangerous for larger trailers and RVs. Cline also told me that he was upset because he heard that the motor cross track is telling people to drive on Maple.

Prior to leaving, I told Cline that he has to allow for emergency vehicles and suggested that he allow the larger vehicles through the roadblock for safety reasons.

We were called back a short time later due to a disturbance escalating to an assault. When we arrived, Deputy Brooks contacted Cline and Deputy Middlekauff contacted the victim and witness. As a crowd started to gather involving upset residents and individuals associated with the motor cross I acted as security and crowd control.

After awhile I was informed by Deputy Middlekauff that the victim moved Cline's sign, drove past where the sign was, then while standing in front of Cline's vehicle waved his mother (who was in a separate vehicle) through. While doing so, Cline used his vehicle to hit the victim with his SUV twice. I was also informed that there was video of the incident.

I contacted the victim away from the crowd. I asked him what he wanted us to do. He told me that he just wanted Cline to get his vehicle off the road. I contacted Cline. I explained to Cline that I understand that it was a private road, and technically the individual who moved the sign may have been considered to have been trespassing; however, using his car to hit him was not reasonable force and is considered assault. I explained to Cline that we could arrest him for assault or, if he agrees to stop his efforts to block the road and leave, we would refer him to the Prosecutor for charging later. Cline agreed to go home.

While leaving the area, I was contacted by some of the neighborhood residents who were upset that Cline was blocking the road.

CASE# **2023-00017537****NARRATIVE****SUPPLEMENTAL REPORT BY DEPUTY MIDDLEKAUFF**

INVESTIGATION: On 09-02-2023 at about 1645 hours, I was dispatched to an assault at 102 S Maple Lane in Port Angeles, WA. Pencom told responding deputies that involved parties were not separated and were yelling at each other. Sergeant Keegan, Deputy Brooks, and I responded to the scene with emergency lights and sirens activated. I arrived and contacted the victim, [7b] [7b] [7b] initially told me that his body had been struck by a vehicle. [7b] declined medical attention.

[7b] told me he had taken a video of the assault. I watched the video and saw a red vehicle (WA: 653ZKY) accelerate forward and appear to run into [7b]. The vehicle is registered to Thomas E. Kline at 663 Cottonwood Lane, Port Angeles, WA. I told Deputy Brooks of what I saw on the video. The following is a summarization of Snider's statement:

VICTIM PARTY STATEMENT by [7b Witness Victim]

- [7b] stated he was leaving the motorcycle track and intended on turning northbound on S Maple Lane but there was a sign and a red truck blocking the roadway.
- [7b] parked his vehicle and got out to move the sign out of the roadway.
- [7b] then directed his friend's mom, [7b Witness], to drive around the red truck.
- The driver of the red truck, identified as Tom Kline, yelled at [7b] about not being able to drive on a private road.
- At the time, Kline's vehicle was parked so [7b] stood in front of the vehicle so [7b] could drive her vehicle next to Snider.
- Kline started to accelerate his vehicle forward and struck [7b] in the stomach with the front of his vehicle.
- [7b] stated Kline was aware he had hit him with his vehicle because Kline told him to get out of the roadway from inside his vehicle.
- [7b] stated he was struck by Kline's vehicle twice in the stomach and left hip area.
- Kline then stopped his vehicle and got out of the vehicle to confront Snider.
- [7b] and Kline yelled at each other then separated and waited for law enforcement to arrive.

I took photographs of [7b]'s stomach and hip area where he was struck by the vehicle. I did not observe any marks. I spoke with [7b]'s juvenile sons, [7c] and [7c]. [7c] and [7c] confirmed [7b]'s statement.

I spoke with [7b] [7b Witness]. [7b Witness] stated she saw Kline strike [7b] two separate times with the vehicle. [7b Witness] watched the incident occur from about 30 feet away.

I spoke with the reporting party, [7b] [7b Witness]. The following is a summarization of his statement:

WITNESS PARTY STATEMENT by [7b] [7b Witness] :

- [7b] lives at [7b Witness Victim] at the intersection of S Maple Ln and S Hemlock Ln.
- [7b] was inside his residence when he heard yelling outside.
- [7b] went outside and saw [7b] standing in the street in front of Kline's vehicle.
- He saw Kline in the driver seat and Kline accelerated the vehicle and struck [7b] twice.
- [7b] said he heard Kline yell, "that's what you get for standing in front of my car" after hitting [7b] with his vehicle.
- Kline exited his vehicle and Kline and [7b] yelled at each other inches away from each other.
- Kline and [7b] separated and waited for law enforcement to arrive.

See Deputy Brooks' report for Kline's statement.

Sergeant Keegan, Deputy Brooks, and I had responded to the same location earlier in the day involving another dispute involving Tom Kline (CCSO #2023-17526). At that call for service, [7b] told me that Kline had jumped in front of a vehicle to prevent them from driving on S Maple Lane.

I took photographs of the scene. [7b] texted the video he took of the assault to my work provided cell phone. Photographs and the video were submitted to CCSO Records.
