Based on the investigation, we determined Tommy was the primary aggressor and instigator in the physical altercation based on several witnesses who were present. 7 initially told me he took Tommy to the ground after he was punched and was fearful of being hit again; however, his written statement was not consistent with this, saying Tommy took him to the ground. Tommy and Brady's statements were very vague and were inconsistent with the amount of injuries 7 sustained. Witnesses also described Brady repeatedly kicking 7 while he was on the ground along with Tommy and it was not in self-defense. Therefore, based on the above information, I have probable cause to arrest Tung (Tommy) Vo for Assault 4th Degree per RCW 9A.36.041.2. NARRATIVE

CASE REPORT: DEPUTY SETH PARKER #C134 **INVESTIGATION:** On 09/29/22, at approximately 1811 hours, I was dispatched to an assault at 93 S. Alder Ln, in Clallam County, Washington. PENCOM had received a call from 7b who reported witnessing two males assault another male and had him on the ground kicking him in the face before everyone separated back to their own property. I arrived on scene and observed several people standing in the street near the address. I was immediately contacted by who informed me she was the President of the Home Owner's Association in Four Seasons Park, and started talking about an ongoing property line dispute between the owner of 93 S. Alder Ln and 111 S Alder Ln. I asked 7b where the primary individuals who were involved were located. 7b pointed to two men further down the street who she said assaulted " 7." Per Theresa, argument and altercation had occurred at the end of the driveway for 93 S. Alder Ln. One of the males 75 pointed at walked over to speak with me and identified himself as Tung Vo (DOB 11/20/82). Tung (Tommy) provided a verbal and written statement, the follow is a summary. Statement by Tommy Vo: given on 09/29/22 Tommy lives at 63 S. Alder place and heard an argument occurring at his neighbor's place (Brady Bedell). Tommy went down to see what was going on and "some guy" (7b Witness) was arguing with Brady. Tommy described 7b as being in Brady's face yelling about the property line dispute between Brady's place and 93 S. Alder Ln. Tommy tried to stop the argument between 7b and Brady when 7b turned and pushed Tommy to the ground. Tommy said it happened very fast and he was trying to kick his way free from 7b because 7b had him down on the ground. Tommy said Brady helped pull 7b off of him, which allowed him to get away. While Tommy was speaking with me, I could smell an odor of an unknown alcoholic beverage about his person and his eyes were glossy. Tommy did have a small red 70 over his left eye and a scratch on his left eyelid. Tommy later allowed me to take photographs of him and these marks. Tommy told me he wanted to press charges against 7 for assaulting him. A friend of Tommy's, 7b Whyte-Simpson, was standing nearby and said he witnessed the altercation as well. 7b provided a verbal and written statement, the following is a summary. - was at Tommy's house at 63 Alder Ln when he heard an argument occurring up the street.
- 7b saw the "bigger guy" (Thomas) try and swing on Tommy.
- then threw his papers down and started to push Tommy down and was hitting him.
- Tommy defended himself and Brady pulled 7b off of Tommy.
- then went after Tommy a second time and Tommy had to defend himself again.

INVESTIGATION CONTINUED:

Sgt. Knutson arrived on scene to assist and started speaking with Brady. 7b had been inside the residence at 93 S. Alder Ln. cleaning blood of his face (per Theresa) and EMS arrived to evaluate his injuries.

I contacted the property owner, 7b Witness () 7b of 93 S. Alder Ln. who was standing in the driveway when I arrived. was only able to provide a short statement because she had to take a family member to the hospital (unrelated to the incident). was provided a written statement form, which she agreed to fill out and provide to me later to include with the case file.

Statement by 7b Witness 7b given on 09/29/22

- described an ongoing property line dispute with Brady, who lives at 111 S. Alder Ln.
- Brady has been working towards building a fence on the property line.
- Brady put a post in the ground, which believed was in violation of the roadway easement, so she notified
 Theresa.
- said 7b (who deals with the HOA roadway issues) came over to explain to Brady why he could not put the fence up where the post was located.
- Brady and 7b were verbally disputing this issue when their other neighbor, Tommy, walk up and started arguing with 7b too.
- Tommy then punched 7b in the face.
- Then next thing she knew, 7b was on the ground and Tommy and Brady were kicking him repeatedly.
- 7b Witness had her cell phone and thought she recorded a video of the assault but realized she did not press record because she was shaking to bad.

7b 7b , advised me she lives with 7b Witness and also witnessed the altercation. 7b did not provide a written statement but the following is a summary of what she reported. Statement by 7b 7b : given on 09/29/22 was sitting in her chair, located inside the residence at 93 S. Alder Ln., while looking out the front window where she can see the end of the driveway. 7b saw and 7b standing on the right side of the driveway and 7b and Tommy were on the left side out in the street. 7b saw Tommy punch 7b in the face and then they disappeared behind the brush on the left side of the driveway. 7b was not able to see what happened once they moved behind the brush. After EMS had evaluated 7b I spoke with him about what occurred. 7b provided a verbal and written statement about what occurred and the following is a summary. Victim statement by 7b 7b; given on 09/29/22. 7b (7) had been made aware of the issues surrounding the fence and property line dispute and received a call from 7b that Brady had put a post in the ground that was outside his property line. 7 went over to 93 S. Alder Ln. to look at the situation when Brady came over from his house yelling at him that he could build the fence were he planned. 7 tried to explain to Brady why he could not build there when Tommy arrived and started interjecting saying they could not do anything to stop it because they had checked with Code Enforcement. 7 had been talking with Brady while Tommy was saying all of this and 7 turned around telling Tommy he did not care. 7 said Tommy got in his face and said, "You want to fight" then punch him in the side of the face. 7 said this took him by surprise and the told Tommy he needed to leave but Tommy came towards him again saying, "so you do want to fight," then took another swing at 7 (didn't make contact) and acted like it was going to try and hit him again. 7 tried pushing Tommy away and then Tommy drug him to the ground (Tom told me verbally he took Tommy to the ground because he believed Tommy was going to hit him again and was not backing away). certify (or declare) under penalty of perjury under the laws of the State of Washington that the foregoing is true and correct. - 7 said when he was on the ground, Tommy and Brady both started kicking him.
- described Tommy as being the main one kicking him in the head, neck, and sides but saw Brady kicking him as well.
- Tried to get up several times but they kept pushing him down, punching and kicking him repeatedly.
- 7 said there were people there who witnessed it that were yelling at Tommy and Brady to stop, which they finally did and 7 was able to get up off the ground.
- Twent to 7b house to clean the blood off his face from his nose bleeding and the cuts on his arms.

completed his written statement at his home where he allowed me to take photographs of his injuries. There were some small lacerations on the sides of his face and his nose appeared swollen. 7 had numerous scrapes on both his forearms, which he said occurred when he was on the ground getting kicked. 7 said he was face down and kept trying get his arms under himself to get up but they would not let him. 7 said he had a lot of soreness in his neck and he initially thought his nose might be broken but did not believe so now. 7 agreed to sign a medical records release form in case he requires medical care for injuries.

Based on the investigation, we determined Tommy was the primary aggressor and instigator in the physical altercation based on several witnesses. 7 initially told me he took Tommy to the ground after he was punched and was fearful of being hit again; however, his written statement was not consistent with this. Tommy and Brady's statements were very vague and were inconsistent with the amount of injuries 7 sustained. Witnesses also described Brady repeatedly kicking while he was on the ground along with Tommy and it was not in self-defense. Brady also allowed me to take photographs of him and I observe redness and a small laceration on the back side of his right hand, over the knuckles.

Therefore, I have probable cause to arrest Tung (Tommy) Vo and Brady Bedell with Assault 4th Degree per RCW 9A.36.041.2.

Both Tommy and Brady were advised of the above charge, interviewed / released.

SUPPLEMENTAL REPORT BY SERGEANT BRIAN D. KNUTSON

INVESTIGATION: On 09/29/2022 at 1818 hours, I arrived at 93 S. Alder Ln, Port Angeles, for the report of an assault.

Upon arriving, Deputy Parker was on scene and collecting statements from the victim and some of the witnesses. I saw a group of three males standing nearby and asked them if anyone was involved with the incident. One of the males, who identified himself as Brady V. Bedell, told me that he was involved. I collected a verbal statement from Bedell regarding the incident. The following is a paraphrased synopsis of Bedell's statement.

SUSPECT INTERVIEW WITH, Brady V. Bedell, 93 S. Alder Ln, Port Angeles, 09/29/2022, 1820 hours:

Bedell has property located at 111 S. Alder Ln. and is going through a property line dispute with the neighbors at 93 S. Alder Ln. Bedell was standing on his side of the property line when a guy (later identified as got up to Bedell's face and was visibly shaking. Bedell said was "nose to nose" with him talking about the by-laws/property line.

Bedell said he couldn't remember how the situation became physical, but at some point he pulled off of his friend "Tommy" (Tung Vo- who lives immediately to the west of 93 S. Alder Ln.). Bedell said he never assaulted during the incident.

INVESTIGATION: While interviewing Bedell, I smelled an odor of intoxicants emitting from his person. I asked Bedell to provide a written statement and he initially agreed to but turned it back to me after writing a few words. Bedell declined to write a statement.

I met with Deputy Parker who requested I interview 7b President of the Home Owner's Association in Four Seasons Park. I met with 7b and obtained a verbal statement. Below is a paraphrased synopsis of 7b Witness statement to me. (Lehman later prepared a written statement which will be filed with CCSO records and included this case investigation.)

WITNESS INTERVIEW WITH, 7b 7b Witness Victim , Port Angeles, 09/29/2022, 1830 hours:

Prior to the assault incident, 7b received a call from a lady named " 7" who lives at 7b Witness . 7b

told 7b about a property line dispute involving the neighboring resident (Bedell). 7b retrieved some maps (property) and met with another neighboring resident, 7b and provided the maps to him to assist with the property dispute.

and 7b walked over to 93 S. Alder Ln. 7b called the owner of the property at 111 S. Alder Ln (Brady's mother) to discuss the property line dispute. 7b had her back toward 93 S. Alder Ln while she was on the phone. 7b heard commotion behind her and when she turned around, the "oriental guy" (Tung Vo a.k.a. "Tommy") and Bedell were kicking and hitting 7b while 7b was on the ground. 7b attempted to get up a few times and Tommy and Bedell continued kicking and hitting 7b get off the ground.

NARRATIVE

On 09-03-2023 at around 1643 hours Deputies Brooks, Middlekauff and I were dispatched to a series of disturbances which led to an assault at the intersection of South Maple Ln and South Hemlock Ln in Four Season's Park involving Thomas Cline blocking the private roadway with his vehicle.

The first disturbance was handled by Deputy Middlekauff, who after a short time on scene had to be rerouted to a trespass in progress. I assisted Deputy Middlekauff at the trespass, and she informed me of what was going on in Four Seasons Park. She also mentioned that due to the road being blocked, she had to drive off the road to get around Cline's roadblock.

At the prior disturbance we contacted the homeowner's association vice-president Thomas Cline. Cline had blocked South Maple Ln with his vehicle and a sign stating that S. Maple Ln was a private road and only open to residents and their guests. Cline stated that he was doing this at the HOA's request as the vehicles associated with the motor cross track are damaging the neighborhood's private roads. Cline said that S. Hemlock is an easement between the track and the neighborhood and that they want the motor cross traffic to stay on S. Hemlock. Cline stated that the HOA has an attorney working on litigating the easement issue, and that they informed him that what he was doing was legal.

However, during this interaction Cline was also blocking access to residents who live on S. Hemlock. The resident who lives at the corner of the intersection was also complaining about Cline's roadblock being in front of his house. During the interaction between Cline and this resident Cline stated that the HOA had a vote and decided to block the road. It was also brought up that the "detour" that Cline was having people travel would be dangerous for larger trailers and RVs. Cline also told me that he was upset because he heard that the motor cross track is telling people to drive on Maple.

Prior to leaving, I told Cline that he has to allow for emergency vehicles and suggested that he allow the larger vehicles through the roadblock for safety reasons.

We were called back a short time later due to a disturbance escalating to an assault. When we arrived, Deputy Brooks contacted Cline and Deputy Middlekauff contacted the victim and witness. As a crowd started to gather involving upset residents and individuals associated with the motor cross I acted as security and crowd control.

After awhile I was informed by Deputy Middlekauff that the victim moved Cline's sign, drove past where the sign was, then while standing in front of Cline's vehicle waved his mother (who was in a separate vehicle) through. While doing so, Cline used his vehicle to hit the victim with his SUV twice. I was also informed that there was video of the incident.

I contacted the victim away from the crowd. I asked him what he wanted us to do. He told me that he just wanted Cline to get his vehicle off the road. I contacted Cline. I explained to Cline that I understand that it was a private road, and technically the individual who moved the sign may have been considered to have been trespassing; however, using his car to hit him was not reasonable force and is considered assault. I explained to Cline that we could arrest him for assault or, if he agrees to stop his efforts to block the road and leave, we would refer him to the Prosecutor for charging later. Cline agreed to go home.

While leaving the area, I was contacted by some of the neighborhood residents who were upset that Cline was blocking the road.

NARRATIVE

SUPPLEMENTAL REPORT BY DEPUTY MIDDLEKAUFF

INVESTIGATION: On 09-02-2023 at about 1645 hours, I was dispatched to an assault at 102 S Maple Lane in Port Angeles, WA. Pencom told responding deputies that involved parties were not separated and were yelling at each other. Sergeant Keegan, Deputy Brooks, and I responded to the scene with emergency lights and sirens activated. I arrived and contacted the victim, 7b 7b initially told me that his body had been struck by a vehicle.

VICTIM PARTY STATEMENT by 7b Witness Victim

- stated he was leaving the motorcycle track and intended on turning northbound on S Maple Lane but there was a sign and a red truck blocking the roadway.
- parked his vehicle and got out to move the sign out of the roadway.
- The then directed his friend's mom, The Witness to drive around the red truck.
- The driver of the red truck, identified as Tom Kline, yelled at 7b about not being able to drive on a private road.
- At the time, Kline's vehicle was parked so stood in front of the vehicle so could drive her vehicle next to Snider.
- Kline started to accelerate his vehicle forward and struck 76 in the stomach with the front of his vehicle.
- stated Kline was aware he had hit him with his vehicle because Kline told him to get out of the roadway from inside his vehicle.
- stated he was struck by Kline's vehicle twice in the stomach and left hip area.
- Kline then stopped his vehicle and got out of the vehicle to confront Snider.
- and Kline yelled at each other then separated and waited for law enforcement to arrive.

I took photographs of 7b s stomach and hip area where he was struck by the vehicle. I did not observe any marks. I spoke with 7b s juvenile sons, 7c c and 7c. 7c Chand 7c t confirmed 7b s statement.

I spoke with 7b 7b Witness. 7b Witness stated she saw Kline strike 7b two separate times with the vehicle.

7b Witness watched the incident occur from about 30 feet away.

The following is a summarization of his statement: WITNESS PARTY STATEMENT by 7b Witness: 7b lives at 7b Witness Victim at the intersection of S Maple Ln and S Hemlock Ln. was inside his residence when he heard yelling outside. went outside and saw 7b standing in the street in front of Kline's vehicle. He saw Kline in the driver seat and Kline accelerated the vehicle and struck 7b twice. said he heard Kline yell, "that's what you get for standing in front of my car" after hitting with his vehicle. Kline exited his vehicle and Kline and vehicle and kline and vehicle are detailed at each other inches away from each other. Kline and 7b separated and waited for law enforcement to arrive. See Deputy Brooks' report for Kline's statement. Sergeant Keegan, Deputy Brooks, and I had responded to the same location earlier in the day involving another dispute involving Tom Kline (CCSO #2023-17526). At that call for service, told me that Kline had jumped in front of a vehicle to prevent them from driving on S Maple Lane. I took photographs of the scene. 7b texted the video he took of the assault to my work provided cell phone. Photographs and the video were submitted to CCSO Records.
