

To schedule a baptism, contact the church office at church@TurnerMonumental.org to arrange a meeting with a member of our clergy team. Before being baptized, candidates will participate in a brief class or conversation to ensure they understand the meaning, purpose, and sacred significance of this sacrament. Baptisms are typically held on third Sundays.

Benevolence Assistance

Turner Monumental provides limited benevolence assistance—**up to \$500 per year per household**, and only for verified emergency needs. We may also refer you to external organizations for additional support when appropriate.

Announcement requests should be submitted by **Friday at 3 p.m**. We prefer that you use the **Announcement Request Form** available on our website, but if needed, you may also submit requests via email to **church@TurnerMonumental.org**.

Death/Funeral Arrangements

Please contact Pastor Cooper *immediately* when a loved one passes. Please <u>DO NOT</u> finalize dates for services without consultation and approval of the Pastor. A Funeral Guide is available on our website.

For spiritual support or pastoral counseling, contact the church office to schedule time with the Pastor or ministerial team.

New Members Orientation

When new members join, they will be scheduled for a New Members Orientation, led by the Assistant Pastor for Ministry. Please ensure your contact information is up to date so we can notify you of upcoming class dates and details.
