Some of the critical High Pressure Gas work that Blackeagle Energy Services performs for Xcel Energy is highly hazardous and triggers numerous OSHA regulatory requirements. Some examples include: abrasive blasting lead, hexavalent chromium and cadmium painted piping and valves, and spray painting flammable and polyurethane paints in enclosed areas. OSHA requirements for this work are extensive, covering the above mentioned hazardous metals, respirable crystalline silica, isocyanates, explosive atmospheres requiring explosion proof and intrinsically safe ventilation, lighting, gas testing, and supplied air respiratory protection with grade D breathing air, respirator training, medicals and fit tests, and OSHA training on all of the above hazards.

Many contractors have sought after this work in recent years, but due to the extensive regulatory requirements and compliance efforts involved, I have only been able to approve two companies to perform this work to date, one of them being Blackeagle, due to George Bunker's conscientious efforts, which have been exemplary.
