NOTICE OF ELECTION 2021

Pursuant to Utah Code Annotated, 10-3-301, Notice is hereby given that there are three open positions on the Dutch John Town Council – Mayor and two Council members. The term for Mayor will be a two (2) year term and each Town Council position will be a four (4) year term, all commencing the first Monday of January, 2022.

Utah Code 20A-9-203 sets forth the qualifications for candidacy:

1. Be a United States citizen at the time of filing
2. Be a registered voter in Daggett County, Dutch John Precinct #1
3. Be a resident of the Town of Dutch John for twelve (12) consecutive months immediately preceding the date of the election –
November 2, 2021.
4. Not be a convicted felon, unless the right to vote or hold office has been restored.

You must declare your candidacy in person with the Town Clerk (Harriet Dickerson) between June 1 and June 7, excluding Saturday and Sunday. The law requires availability during regular business hours. Since we do not have regular business hours, I, or my designee, will be available at my house – 103 2nd Ave – between Tuesday, June 1, and Monday June 7, 2021, (excluding Saturday June 5, and Sunday June 6) between the hours of 8:00 am. and 5:00 p.m. Filing period closes on Monday, June 7th at 5:00 p.m. No filings will be accepted after that time.

The position of Mayor is only a two-year term to complete the term vacated by Bud Rogers. Sandy Kunkel assumed this position.

Election will be by mail-in-only balloting again this year. We will be verifying signatures through the County/State database.
