

Women's Club of Hollister Coupons for the Military Program

Guidelines

Commissaries request that the coupons be bagged as follows:

1. Cut out the coupons.
2. Sort coupons into two piles by status:
 - a. Expired. Not expired more than 2 months. (e.g. if today's date is 12/1/2018, you would cut out coupons with an expiration date that is not older than 10/1/2018.
 - b. Unexpired. At least two months of life left.
3. Sort each of those two piles into four piles by type:
 - a. Food items
 - b. Non-food items
 - c. Baby food/items
 - d. Pet items (like dog food)
4. Stuff them into plastic baggies.
5. Write the status (Expired or Unexpired) and the type (food, non-food, baby, or pet) on them.
6. Total the retail savings of the baggies and write it on them. This helps us track the value of the overall program.
7. Bring them to the next WCH Luncheon and leave them at the registration desk for Raquel Morgan.

Only "Manufacturer's Coupons" can be used. They can be from the newspaper, dispensers in grocery stores, tear-pads, and elsewhere as long as they state "Manufacturer's Coupon" on them. No assistance vouchers. No food stamps. No store coupons. No restaurant coupons. No Internet coupons.
