Yes, I know D Ray James is a private-owned facility. The GEO group actually owns many of the correctional institutions where my clients are or have been housed. Very unpleasant to deal with them. They make their own rules and a LOT of profit. It's the prison industrial complex. I heard the pension and 401K plans of school teachers, firefighters, and other state and federal employees' are the #1 investors in private prisons. It's terrible.

Did Mr. Lino send you the money for Rogerio's account yet?

We are FedExing to your son all of my commentary to his motion as well as pleadings from the 9th Circuit in the FedEx prosecution.

The documents are too large to scan, so Emilio is mailing you a copy.

Going to Mr. Lino's request, my office federal express overnighted to your wife a check in the amount of \$2000 for Mr. Scotton's phone calls. You should be receiving it today.

The separate note, the only way Rogério can qualify for (1) a transfer to a closer institution (such as in the Southern District of Florida) and (2) a Bond pending appeal for his immigration hold (I-247) to be lifted so that the federal Bureau of Prisons. This is necessary as well.

I had plans to go visit Rogério at his prison this weekend and posible through Monday, but now I got an urgent message from Ovidio Silva. I will try to get a phone call with Rogério this morning, or at least this afternoon, so he can tell me what is going on.

Richard, this is Rogerio Scotton. Today, March 6, 2015, I received a copy of the brief that you filed in my case on March 2. I was completely stunned and upset to see that not only you completely disregarded everything we had discussed, but you also lied to me by saying you had included my additional arguments from my draft brief that I sent to you, with my 16 issues, when I now see that you did not. Ms. Kimiko, under the appeal court docket there is no document that shows that Ms. Kristin Figueroa Contreras is Rogerio's lawyer or that she is currently representing him under his direct appeal for that matter. Ms. Kristin Figueroa Contreras has not sent any documents to the Court of appeals for the Eleventh Circuit that would show her as the appellant attorney. Until she sends a register document (notice of appearance) by law, she is not representing Rogerio in his direct appeal. As of today the docket of Rogerio's direct appeal shows Richard Klugh as the appointed attorney to represent him in his direct appeal. Ms. Kristin Figueroa Contreras took \$65,000 to represent my son in his direct appeal, something she has not done all these months. We have already asked for the money back on many occasions. There was no response from Contreras. Ms., Contreras even lies about working together with the court appointed Richard Klugh, something that she has clear knowledge that is illegal. We are wasting time and Ms. Contreras is also wasting our time and so far, have prejudiced Rogerio very much. Please tell her that we need the money back so Mr. David Bogenschutz could appeal Rogerio's case. Something smells very bad, and we do not understand why Contreras take the money to appeal Rogerio's case and she refuse even to submit the notice of appearance to the Court.
