Day 1: Good Fri, April 7: Rome – Begin Your Tour
Arrive in Rome and transfer to hotel. Depending on arrival
time, start with the Pantheon before attending the Via
Crucis ceremony led by the Pope. Overnight: Rome.



Colosseum - Walk through the Classic Sites of Rome Imagine what Roman life was like by exploring the Roman forum, the place where everything happened and where Caesar, Cicero, and Augustus worked. Pass by the Arch of Titus and the Mamertine Prison, the place of Peter and Paul's imprisonment. After lunch, imagine yourself to be a gladiator or spectator at the timeless symbol of Rome: the

Colosseum. Overnight: Rome. (B)

# Day 3: Easter Sun, April 9: Ostia Antica and St. Paul's Outside the Walls – Visit Rome's Port and St. Paul Start the morning with a visit to one of the best-preserved archaeological sites outside Rome: Ostia Antica. This is Rome's ancient port where the apostles Paul and Peter docked. This incredible site offers a wonderful place to consider how Christians in the Bible lived their daily lives.

Afterward, visit St. Paul's Outside the Walls, which houses the remains of St. Paul. Overnight: Rome. (B)



Day 4: Mon, April 10: Lateran, Catacombs, Crypt – Discover Catholicism's HQ and Explore the Cities of the Dead

Begin at St. John's Church in Lateran, the pope's seat in Rome and perhaps the most historically rich church. Afterward, stop at the Church of Quo Vadis, where Jesus famously met Peter before Peter was killed. Then trek underground in the Catacombs, the place where early Christians buried their dead. Afterward, visit Rome's most eerily interesting museum: a living cemetery of monks whose bodies are converted into furniture. An alternative is to learn about immigration in Rome with a nonprofit. Overnight: Rome. (B)

## Day 5: Tues, April 11: St. Peter's and Vatican – Tour the Greatest Church and Museum on Earth

St. Peter's Basilica is the largest church on the planet, the most historically significant, and the unofficial center of the Roman Catholic Church. It's the size of a small city, with its most important relic lying deep beneath the altar. Visit Vatican's St. Peter's Square, the church, Vatican museums, the city, and, of course, walk through the Sistine Chapel. Enjoy one final dinner in Rome before departing home in the morning. Overnight: Rome. (B, D)





Day 6: Wed, April 12: Departure – Return Home Say *ciao* to your wonderful excursion and begin the journey back home from Rome's Airport. (B)
