FONTRA

There will be meetings on multi-tenant homes including the use of homes and condominium units as Air BnB rentals. The City is also considering sidewalk cafes and their use.

STREET REPS

There is currently nothing to report on this. The board discussed having approximately 5 street reps.

ROSEHILL RESERVOIR

The board discussed the current status. There are useful photo slides on the City website that outline the proposed plan. The vision committee has made significant progress on tree retention. There are still issues with the impact on the Little Park. It appears that construction will commence in the spring of 2018 and will continue for three years. The board expressed concern on the length of time that the Little Park would be unusable.

RAVINE UPDATE

The board thanked John Bossons for all of his work in this project. The ravine strategy report should be issued by the City shortly.

The minutes of the meeting of June 19, 2017 were accepted as amended.

MEMORIAL FOR TIM CROOKS

Susan Stock reported on the progress and plans for planting.

MEMBERSHIP

The board discussed the issue of membership fees from condominiums and the communication from 21 Shaftesbury that it would no longer pay a bulk amount but would leave it to individual owners to become members of the SRA>

DEVELOPMENT ISSUES

Deborah Briggs reported that the Scrivener Square plans had been altered to produce a better design. There will be a briefing of the board at the next meeting.

Susan Stock reported on the historic aspects of the building located at 81R Woodlawn East.
