Signalling System**

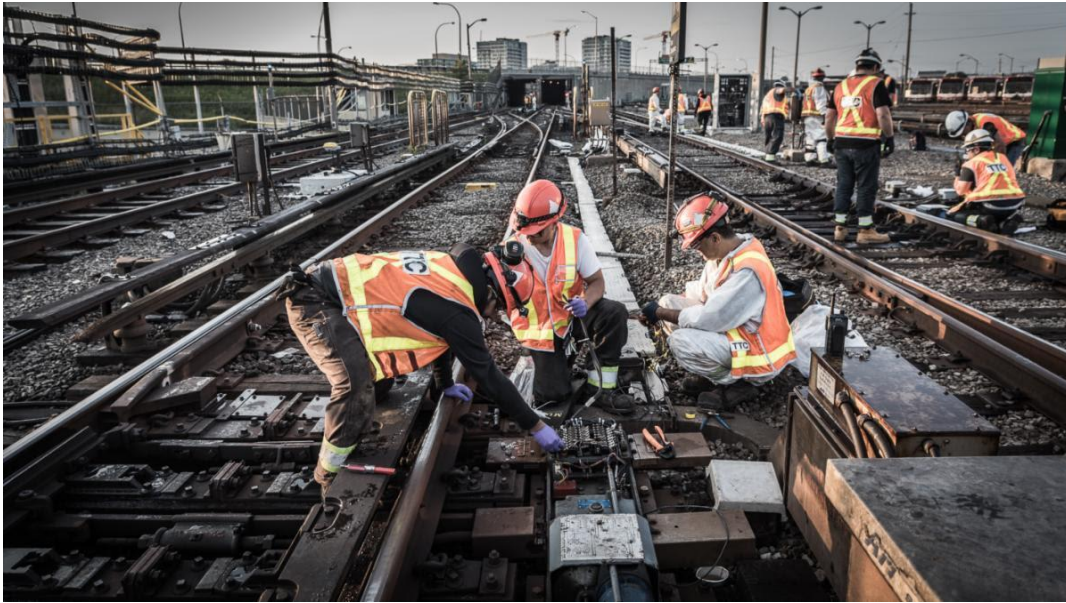

The TTC's modernized Automatic Train Control (ATC) signalling system is now fully operational on Line 1, bringing with it improved service and reduced operating costs.

The completion of ATC on Line 1 also means that trains can use electricity more efficiently, leading to lower operating costs for the TTC. In addition, it will allow for more service flexibility if there is an operational issue on the line, with additional turn-back locations now available. TTC Connects: Women as Transit Operators



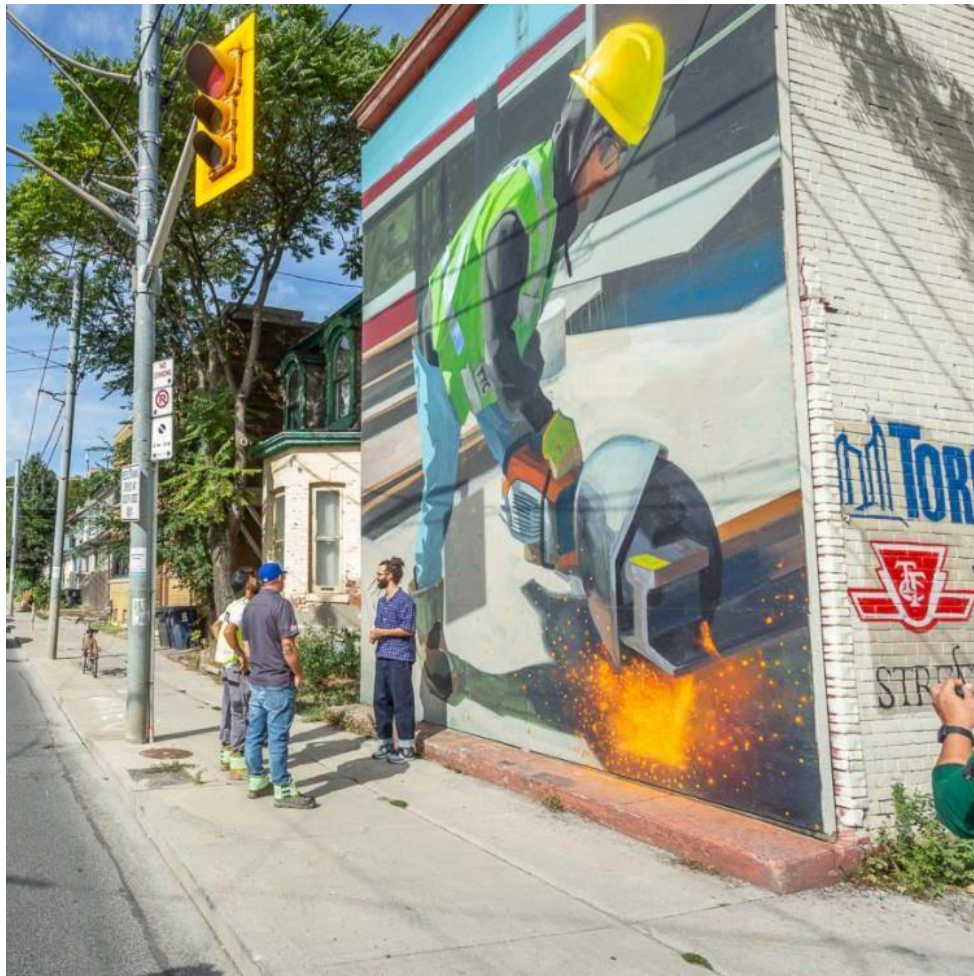

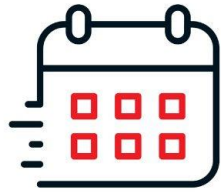
New Mural at the Hillcrest Complex

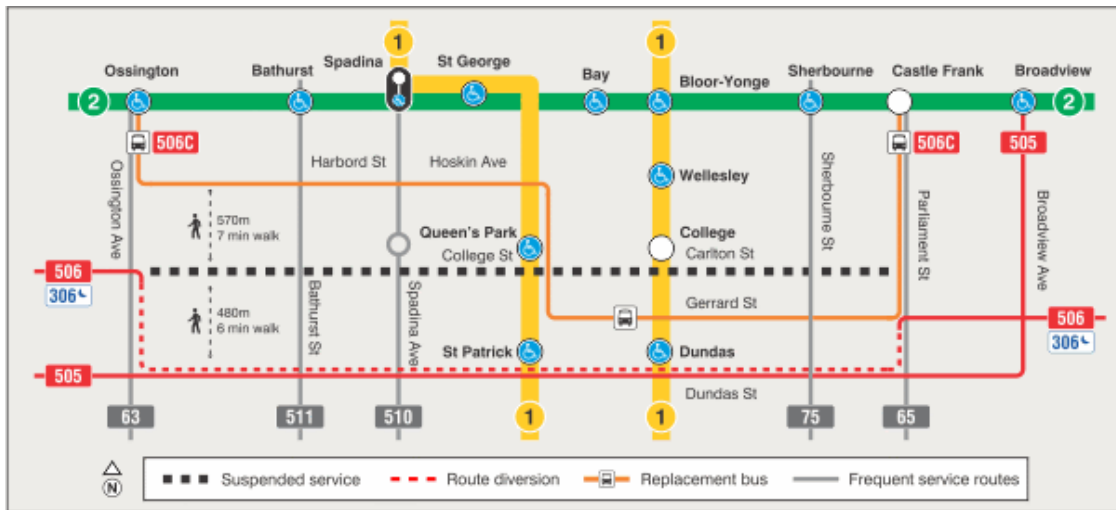
TTC Service Adjustments

Revised Service on a Portion of 506 Carlton Route Due to Construction

Effective October 13, TTC suspended service on the 506 Carlton between Ossington Avenue and Parliament Street to accommodate several construction projects in this area. These include: streetcar track replacement, cycling and pedestrian infrastructure upgrades, transit stop improvements, hydro utility repairs and streetscape improvements. TTC Testing Public Wi-Fi on Select Bus Routes



The TTC is testing free public Wi-Fi as part of a pilot project on the following bus routes:

- 34 Eglinton East
- 35 / 935 Jane
- 102 / 902 Markham Road
- 165 Weston Road North

Buses that have Wi-Fi enabled have a decal posted on the bus. This is another way the TTC is enhancing the experience for our customers and making it easier for people to stay connected on the go.
