

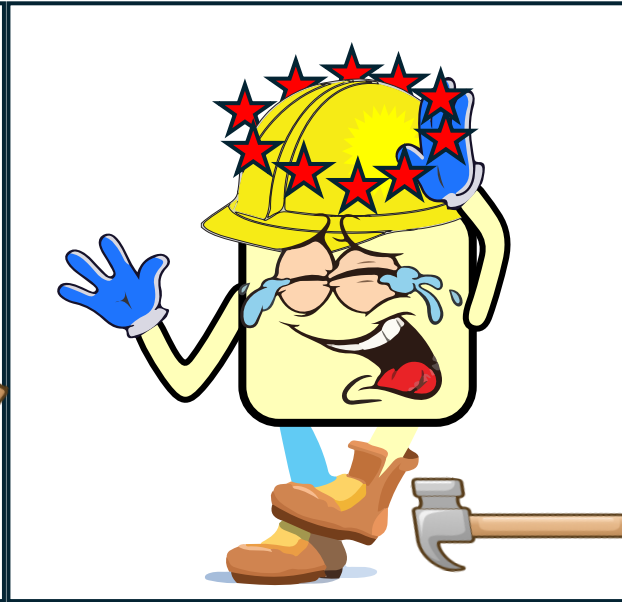
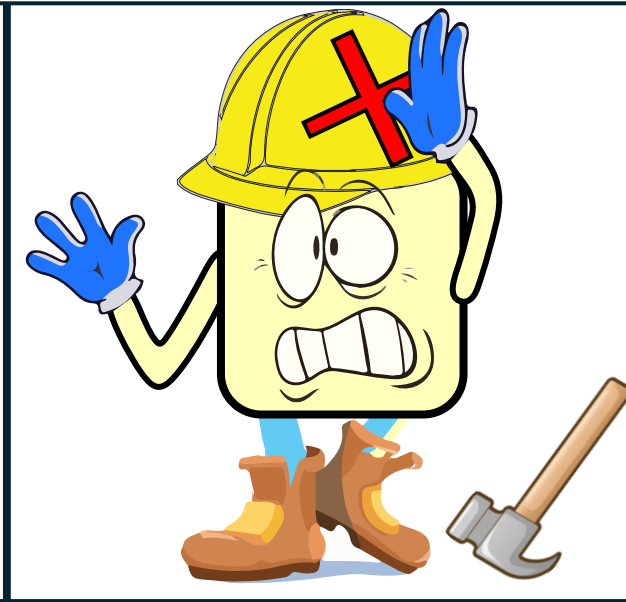
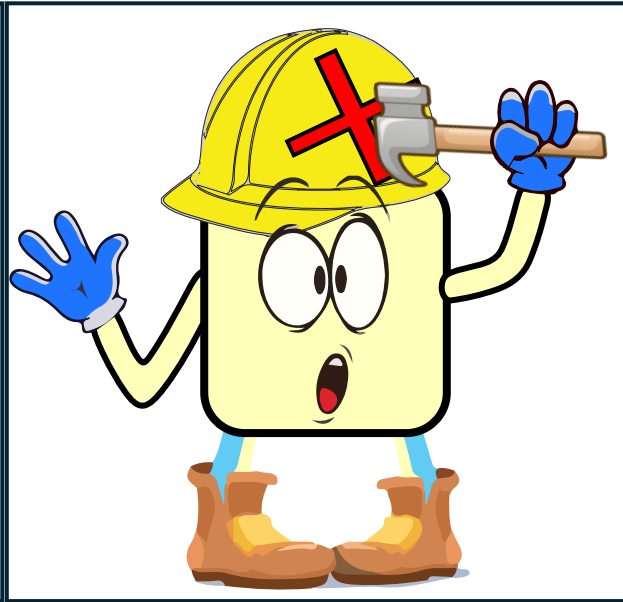
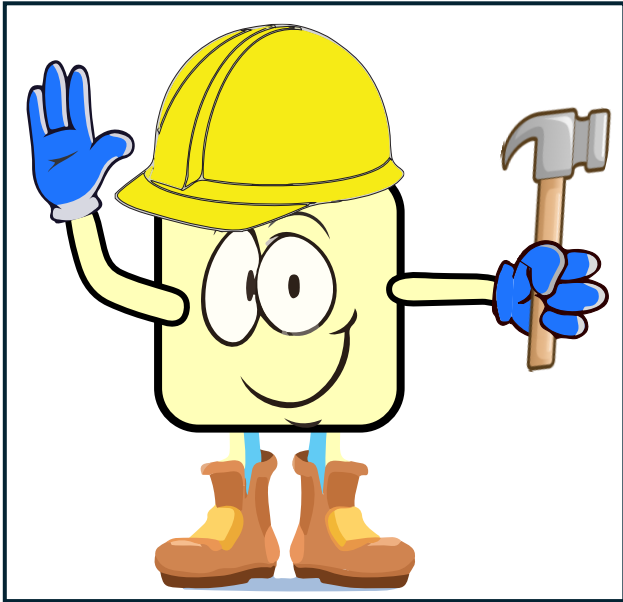
## Character Gallery

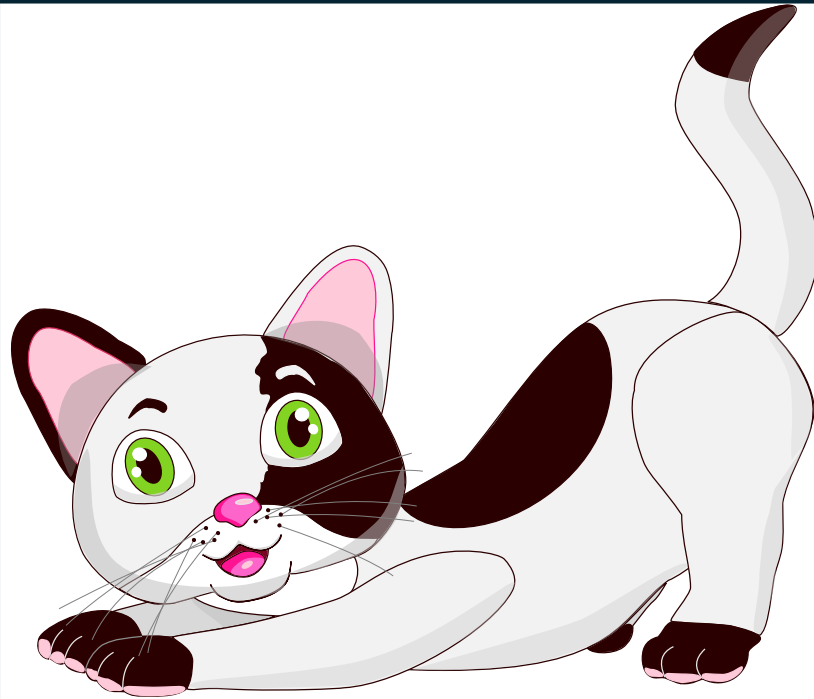

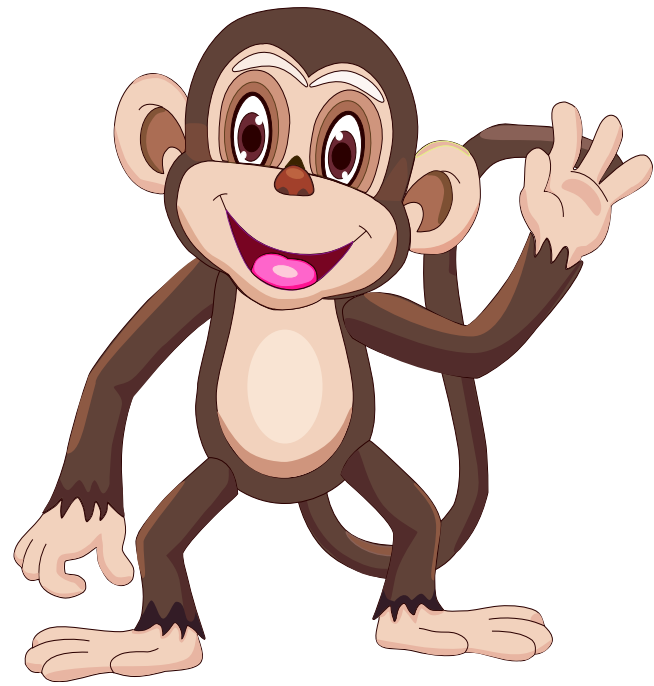
I also created an animal alphabet that I turned into a large poster for the kid's corner in the reception area of a non-profit.

I also create learning products with standard stock images.











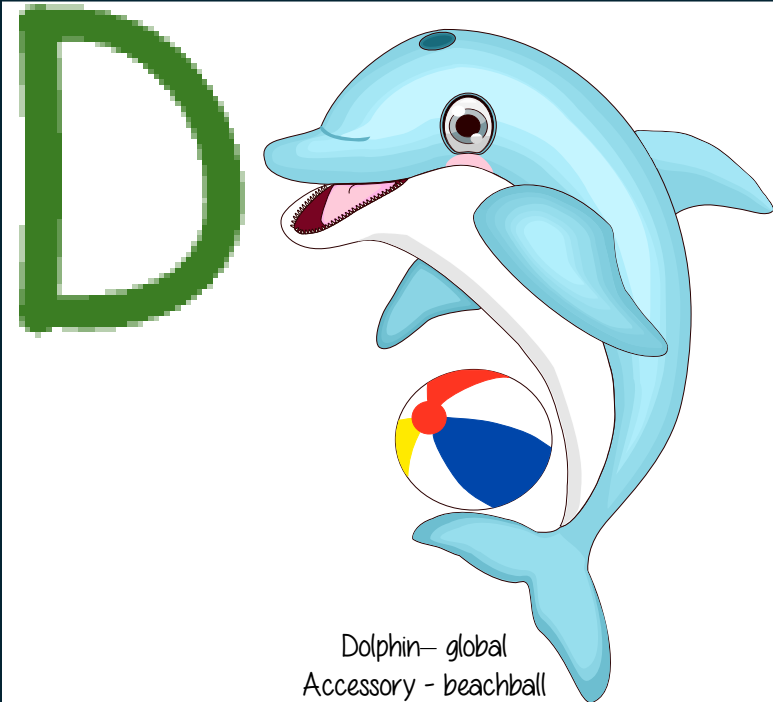

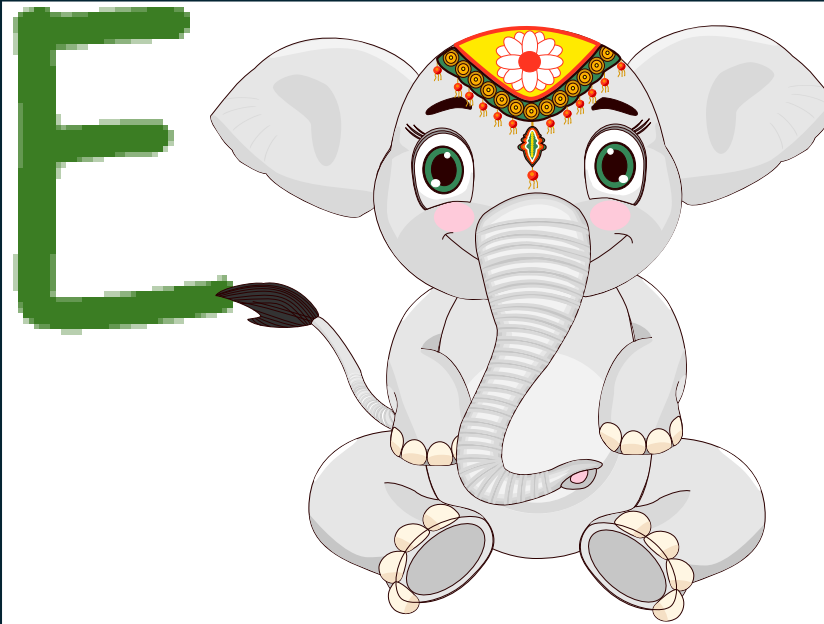
Brown bear – United States of America

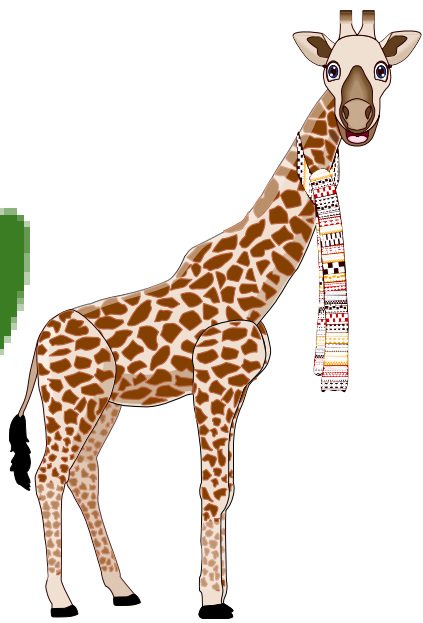

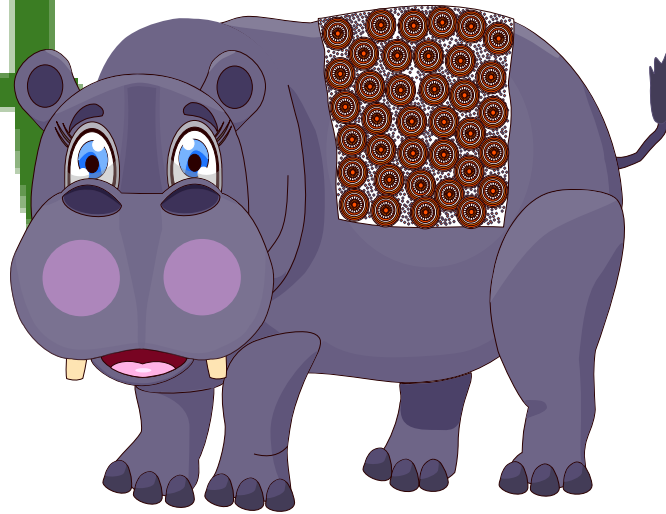

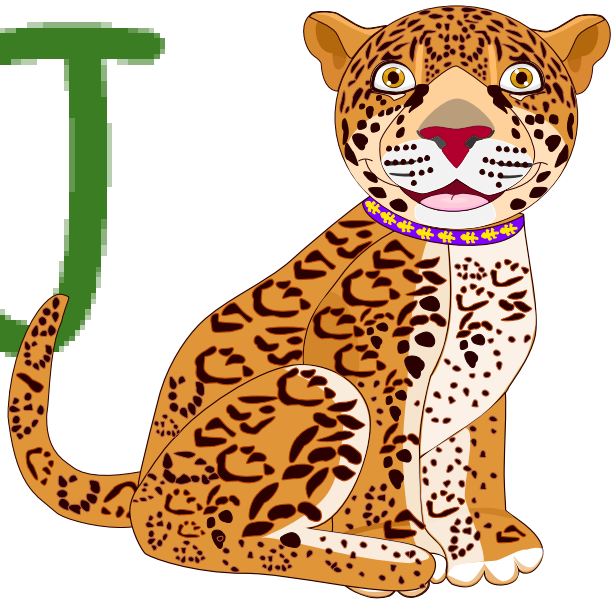

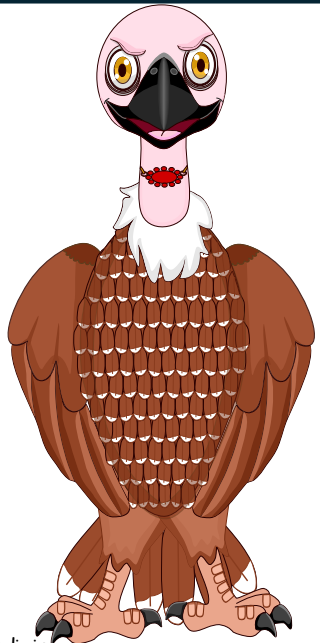

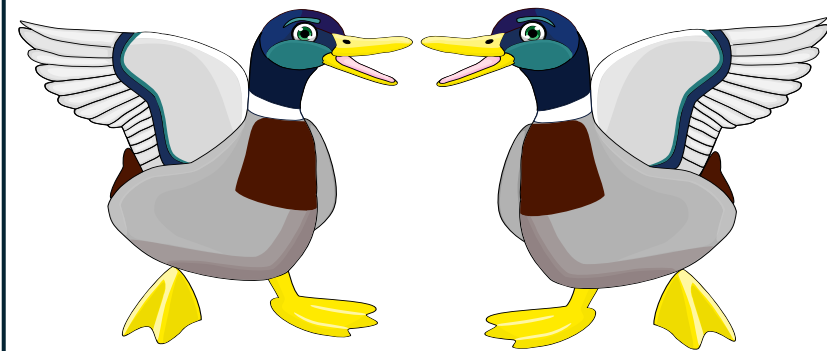
