- God is a Covenant God. Everything He does is out of Covenant... His Word, His promises, His commitment to His people. He does nothing outside of Covenant.
- 2. In Covenant, we hold relationship as a highest priority.
- <u>Life IS relationship</u>
- 3. Asher teaches, Covenant is what protects intimate relationships.
- 4. Covenant relationship, is a target of the enemy.
- **5.** Covenant relationship involves a heart-bond that transcends all opposing forces.
- 6. What it takes to be in Covenant, committed relationships are the very qualities God wants built into our lives as He works to make each of us more like Him.
- 7. We cannot fully become like Him without each other. We ARE one body, with one Head, and one Spirit. And He is calling us to live that out ...TOGETHER!

Basics

- Definition: Any agreement between 2 or more people in which certain actions are performed. The terms of covenant are mandatory on both sides and on all participants. Pledge of total loyalty and commitment. It is irrevocable
- 2. Covenant is counter-cultural.
- 3. Covenant is the way God relates to His people.

- 4. One of the pillars of covenant is obedience.
- 5. God gave the law to give them boundaries.
- 6. You cannot separate the Gospel from the Covenant. Martin Luther said:
 - a. The OT is to show us our sin
 - b. The NT is to show us our Savior.
- 7. In the NT God performs both sides of the Covenant.
- 8. Covenant is the foundation of our faith. Yet, few Christians are aware of it or know much about it.
 - a. Churches don't teach about the blood. Blood is a requirement.
 - b. Many churches are trying to be culturally relevant.
- 9. We regain Covenant by stepping into it by faith.
- 10. Pillars of Covenant are Trust, transparency, integrity, obedience to God, sacrifice, and worship.

Four Areas of Covenant Living – All 4 of us

HOME

- 1. Biblical Covenant marriage and then family, has turned into a "contract."
- 2. Contracts were the result of broken covenants.
- 3. Covenant before marriage helps hold it together and protects the intimacy.
- 4. Covenant can extend beyond marriage and family to include those who don't have homes and even don't know the Lord.

CHURCH

- 1. Church membership isn't necessarily covenant.
- 2. We can't be in covenant with everyone, and that includes church leaders.
- 3. We are called to love everyone, but not necessarily be in covenant with everyone, only as the Lord leads us.

BUSINESS

- 1. If possible, don't be unequally yoked.
- 2. We are not to have two different standards, one in the church and a different one in business. We are not to be hypocritical, but people of integrity. We live our faith in all places, consistently.
- 3. Everything we do reflects our character.

GOVERNMENT (NOT politics)

- 1. Our nation began in Covenant with God. We have stepped out of that, as a nation.
- 2. The answer is to return to God.

EQUIPPING

- 1. We all have soul wounds. They are road blocks and they keep you from being in covenant relationship.
- 2. Covenant has been lost, but we can reinstitute it into every aspect of our lives.
