This is an initial application form and is not a guarantee on approval to sell. Once my application is submitted, I understand that the market manager will pass it along to the Advisory Committee for review and approval. If there are any questions, the Advisory Committee and/or market manager will reach out.
If I was a vendor in the past and had any violations or infractions in prior seasons, I understand that the Advisory Committee might require a meeting with me before approving my application.
Once approved, I promise to pay my annual fee of \$25 and then a weekly stall fee of \$10 per market I attend. I also promise to keep my insurance policy up to date. (non-profit and community organizations are excluded from this fee).
I understand that if I have any questions or concerns regarding my booth or the market that I have the right to address them to the market manager and/or the Advisory Committee. I understand that the market manager is not in charge of making vendor and product decisions and brings these applications and inquiries to the Advisory Committee to vote on. The Advisory Committee is always open to hear ideas from all vendors at any time so please reach out.
I understand that vendor decisions are made based on seniority, the vendor's prior seasons behavior at the market, size and ownership of business (family and small scale over corporate large scale), products that are unique, in demand and, add to the overall balance and cultural diversity of the products available at the market, products that if added to the market will not create too many of the same or similar products, sellers ability to directly participate in the market in lieu of sending an employee, ability to successfully interact with other vendors and the market staff, local production (Mariposa, Merced, Madera counties), and vendors committing to the entire season.
I have read the Mariposa Certified Farmers' Market Rules and Regulations, and if selected as a vendor, will abide by those and all rules and policies of market regulatory departments, including US Department of Agriculture, California Department of Food and Agriculture, Department of Environmental Health, California Department of Public Health, and City of Operation rules and regulations in place for outdoor farmers markets.
