2. Please let us know what you are hoping to sell this season. Please be as specific as possible. You will only be approved for what is written down on this form. If you want to bring anything new during the season, please check with the manager first. If it is easier to write “everything on my Certified Producers Certificate” you can. You can also say “everything on my CPC except...”. The Mariposa Farmer’s Market Advisory Committee will be responsible for approving items for you to sell. The advisory committee takes into account the current “supply and demand” for your product at our market when it makes its decision.

3. Will you be selling with a second certificate for the Agricultural Vendor side of the market? If so, for whom? Make sure to include their Certified Producer’s Certificate as well.

4. Please include the following forms with your application:
- Signed Agreement and Hold Harmless (these are Exhibits A and B which can be found at the end of the Market rules and are also attached to this application).
  - Current copy of your Certified Producer's Certificate (for Agricultural vendors). This should list Mariposa County as a county you sell in.
  - Current certificate of liability insurance listing the "Alliance for Community Transformations, Mariposa Certified Farmer's Market and their respective directors, officers, employees, staff and agents" With an address of 5029 Stroming Road, Mariposa CA 95338 Insurance doesn't have to start until May 3<sup>rd</sup>.
  - A copy of any of the following forms based on what you are selling:
    - Health Department Permit/cottage food license/food cart permit from the health department (selling prepared food)
    - Nursery License (selling nursery stock, or cut flowers)
    - CDFR Organic Registration (for anyone selling organic agricultural products)
    - CDPH organic registration (for anyone selling organic processed products)
    - Certified Organic certificate (i.e. from CCOF)
    - CA Egg license (for anyone selling eggs)
    - CA Prop 12 Animal Care Registration (selling shell eggs, liquid eggs, whole pork meat or whole veal meat)
    - A copy of your label if selling meat that shows it is USDA approved
