ARENAS : if weather permits, all tests will be held on 20x60 meters sand x GGT footing outdoor ring. Entrance made from inside the ring. Warm up in indoor arena sand x GGT footing 20x56.

If heavy rain, all tests will be held in 20x56 meter ring and warm up will be arranged in the same ring in between classes and before ride.

No lunging in the rings – the only area available for lunging is in the sand paddock (stone dust), not leveled.

ASTM APPROVED HELMETS must be worn at all time when riding.

DOGS ALLOWED, only on leash at all times.

NO UNENTERED HORSE ALLOWED.

PENDING EHV-1 outbreaks situation, a few stalls may be available for \$35 for the day (\$50 deposit).

Championships show at Willsway Equestrian Center in Goshen, NY on Saturday October 1st 2022.

Champion and Reserve Champion to be awarded at each level and in each division, ribbons to 6th place, special prizes and awards, lap of honor... – join us for the first edition of our Hudson Valley Dressage show series and Championships!

Qualifying Rules for the Championships classes at the Championships show :

- 1- Open to all competitors and open to any horse.
- 2- A horse/rider combination must earn TWO qualifying score of 60% or more at TWO of the 2021 participating Hudson Valley Dressage shows – see list below.
- 3- Scores need to be from the highest test of the level, except for Introductory level, where it will be Intro B.
- 4 – Note : All regular classes will also be offered at the event for those who did not qualify.

Championships classes rules:

- 1 - The same rider/horse combination must compete – no substitution possible.
- 2 - A horse can enter no more than two consecutive levels.
- 3 – No whips allowed for the Championship classes. Only rider can warm up horse for the Championship classes.
- 4 – All test ridden from memory for the Championship classes.
- 5 – USEF rules to be followed for qualifying shows and championship classes.
- 5 – Champion, Reserve Champion, and third through 6th placings will be awarded in each divisions : Junior/Young rider, Amateur and Open.
