We made 57 contacts and many of the operators have not had real contest experience (remember FD is not a contest). Overall, some 15 members came and helped set up, operate and give moral support. Many lessons learned... Next year we will do the same but move our operating times to Sunday afternoon...

<u>CARA Business Meeting Minutes</u> <u>Monday 12/1/2025</u>

- The meeting was called to order at 7:31pm by Bud W1NSK, President.
 - o There was a quorum: 11 members were present
 - o The meeting was held on Teams
- The minutes from the previous meeting as presented in the CAPERS Blog were accepted.
- The Treasurer's report as presented in the CAPERS Blog was accepted
 - The treasurer presented the 2026 budget based on the \$40 dues structure and 50 members. After discussion the budget was approved.
 - The treasurer noted that the latest CD was 3.7%.
 - The treasurer noted that the 2026 dues collection process will begin in December.

Committee Reports

- Repeater Committee: Steve W1SMS Chair
 - o The 2m machine is stable.
 - Equipment removed from Spruce Mountain not needed at this time is in storage in Danbury.
 - The next project is to add a local Raspberry Pi based Echolink to the system – this will eliminate the (current) RF link, provide better audio as well as being integrated so that an Echolink or received signal would have priority – whichever signal arrives at the repeater first.
 - The two Yaesu repeaters have yet to be cleaned and repaired.
- Stephanie reported that all is well with our website. There was discussion about an ARRL Website Contest. Steph will file our website as an entry.
- CAPERS blog content is due on December 3rd. There was discussion about an ARRL newsletter contest. It was discussed we should file by January our last 12 CAPERS thru 8/25 in the old format. Someone will have to take this on and file the documents and application form.
- VE Testing is next scheduled for first Saturday in December. John WIJMA will contact Jon, AJIU for the dates in 2026.
- The next club POTA is in April 2026

- It was discussed and decided to Operate as a club effort the ARRL 10m Contest on Saturday 12/13 from 10am to 4pm at the Ball Pond FD. We will have one rig and Mike, W8ZY will bring a 10m Yagi. One-hour operating slots will be available from 11am to 4pm after the set up at 10am.
- The next hamfest is Southington in March of 2026 to continue our fundraising efforts through the sale of donated equipment. The current inventory of equipment is being stored in N2DGT's shed

Old Business

- There was follow up discussion on the club's ARRL Nov SS SSB contest effort. Overall, it was a great success. 14 club members came out to participate. The major take away was to move our effort to Sunday afternoon next year.
- Bud reported there were 16 members and family signed up for the Christmas Dinner on 12/18 at the Vespucci Club. 2 seats remain.

New Business

- The December meeting will be another Elmers night. POTA and APRS will be some of the short presentations. Other topics are welcome
- John W1JGM noted that Jon K1RFD had donated a 2m rig for the APRS project.
- We discussed the Winter FD at the Ball Pond FD the last weekend of January. We will go with the same set up of rig and antennas as we did for the ARRL SS SSB. We will use the N3FJP winter FD logging software which has been installed on the club computer.
- John W1JMA mentioned that he will now allow QRZ log proof for the "Worked all CT counties" award. He will update the documents and update the website and QRZ page with this information. There was no objection to this change.
