Contact Hours

8:00 am-3:30 pm for the school office. To meet with the principal, please contact the school office to request an appointment. If a child is to be absent, please call the school office by 9:00 am.

School Hours

Students may arrive as early as 7:30am and wait in the foyer until 7:45 to go to their lockers. Students must be picked up by 3:15pm or enter our AfterCare program. The first class begins at 8:00am with the last class ending at 3:00pm. Students must be in their classroom by 8:00am to be considered on time.

Cell Phones

Students may bring a cell phone, however cell phones must be left in their locker and are NOT to be used during class time except by permission of their teacher.

Lunch

Students need to bring a sack lunch. Juice, bottled water, and perhaps Gatorade will be available for purchase. (We are staying away from the pop; however, if you wish to bring it in your lunch, that is fine.) There are a few microwaves that may be used to warm up lunch items from home.

Chapels

The majority of the time, Chapels occur on Wednesdays at 8:00 a.m. Parents are welcome to attend. Chapels will generally be held in the auditorium.

P.E. Uniforms

Athletic shorts as close to knee length and T-shirts or athletic shirts such as Starter or Adidas with a small logo. Please no white shirts or shorts.

Visitors

The campus is closed. Individuals will not be able to enter the building freely after 8:00am. The school secretary will need to let you in. Students are *not* to open the doors for anyone to enter. They will need to get an adult to come open the door. If an individual wants to visit, they need to get approval at least a day in advance from the principal.

Medication

**No** student should have medication on them or in their lockers. If it is necessary for a student to take medication during the school day, the medication with student's name, proper instructions and a note from the parent must be given to the school nurse.

Early Dismissal  
for Seniors

Seniors fulfilling all the academic requirements *may* be eligible for early dismissal. (2:10 p.m.) A permission form will need to be completed by the student and parent, and approved by the Academic Director.

Student Drivers

Student drivers will need to complete a driving form with the school office before the end of the first week of school. Reckless driving will result in the student losing the privilege to drive to school. Upon arrival, students are to enter the school immediately. Students are not to loiter in the car.

School Hours

Students may arrive as early as 7:45 am. (Extended care students may arrive and leave at their scheduled times). School begins at 8:00 am and ends at 3:00 pm. Students must be in their classroom by 8:00 am to be considered on time. All students **not** in extended care should be picked up by 3:15 pm each day.

Lunch

Students need to bring a sack lunch. Due to the number of students, we cannot microwave lunch items. Chocolate milk or white milk will be available for purchase. A lunch fee of \$3.00 will be charged to students without a lunch and whose parents cannot be reached. Lunch will consist of peanut butter or cheese crackers, applesauce and granola bar.

Chapels

Chapels will be held on Thursday mornings - 8:30 a.m. for grades K-4. Students in grades 5-6 will join in with the Middle/High school students for Chapel on Wednesday mornings at 8:00 a.m. Students may dress in regular classroom dress on Chapel days. Parents are welcome to attend.

Visitors

Students are *not* to open the doors for anyone to enter. They will need to get an adult to come open the door. If an individual would like to visit a class, they need to get approval at least a day in advance from the teacher/principal.

Medication

**No** student should have medication on their person or in their book bags. If it is necessary for a student to take medication during the school day, the Medication Authorization form should be filled out, signed by a parent and the instructions thereon followed. All medications should be left in the office with the school nurse.
