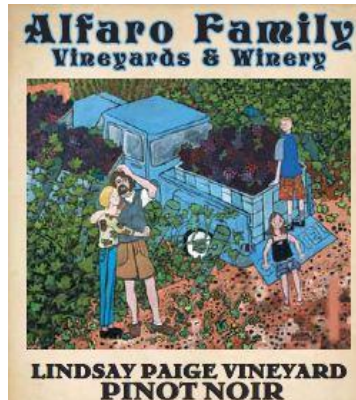


2017 “Lindsay Paige Vineyard” Estate Pinot Noir



The Vineyard:

Lindsay Paige Vineyard is named after the Alfaro's daughter. Planted in 1998, the vineyard covers a little more than 7 acres on a northwest facing hillside between 550 and 650 feet elevation. The upper portion is planted to Pinot Noir. This high density planting (almost 2000 vines per acre) consists of clones 113,114, 115, 667, 777, 828, 359, 475, Pommard 4 and Pommard 5. The soil type is sandy and gravelly loam. The grapes were hand-harvested on September 18, 19 & 20, 2017.

The Wine:

Abundant floral and spice elements up front lead to a ripe Bing cherry and blackberry core on the palate. This wine has a rich, velvety texture with well-integrated tannins and acidity – all the hallmarks of our flagship vineyard.
