
2018 Ryan Spencer Vineyard Estate Syrah



The Vineyard:

Ryan Spencer Vineyard, named after the Alfaro's son, was planted in 2001. It is comprised of seven acres broken into different blocks on a very steep hill between 450 and 800 feet in elevation. La Escalera is a terraced hillside block planted to Hermitage clones of Syrah. On the top of the hill is Mrs. K's block; half of the block is planted to Syrah clones 470, 877 and 174, and the other half is planted to the heirloom Pinot Noir clones Swan, Mt. Eden, Martini and Pommard. The vine is density over 2300 vines per acre and the soil type is sandy loam.

The Wine:

The nose is full of wildflowers, spices, mixed berries, and subtle espresso bean notes, leading to a lush palate of blackberry, dark plum, and cherry liqueur.
