
2019 "Lindsay Paige Vineyard" Estate Pinot Noir



The Vineyard:

Lindsay Paige Vineyard is named after the Alfaro's daughter. Planted in 1998, the vineyard covers a little more than 7 acres on a northwest facing hillside between 550 and 650 feet elevation. The upper portion is planted to Pinot Noir. This high-density planting (almost 2000 vines per acre) consists of clones 113,114, 115, 667, 777, 828, 359, 475, Pommard 4 and Pommard 5. The soil type is sandy and gravelly loam. The grapes were hand-harvested on September 18, 19 & 20, 2019.

The Wine:

Abundant floral and spice elements up front lead to a ripe Bing cherry and blackberry core on the palate. This wine has a rich, velvety texture with well-integrated tannins and acidity – all the hallmarks of our flagship vineyard.
