

Brand Integrity and Copyright Infringement Audit: Unauthorized Registry Representation of Educational Assets

Introduction and Administrative Audit Scope

This audit provides a forensic evaluation of intellectual property ownership and administrative alignment concerning a series of specialized emergency medical training curricula. The investigation is initiated in response to evidence from the United States Copyright Office database showing a comprehensive portfolio of copyright registrations filed under the name of Taylor Sprecher. These proprietary works, which focus on transgender patient protocols and medical scenarios for emergency responders, are currently listed on the Oregon Health Authority (OHA) Cultural Competence Continuing Education (CCCE) registry under a different primary contact and trainer.

The primary objective of this audit is to identify the unauthorized use, administrative representation, and gatekeeping of these proprietary educational assets by third-party entities. Specifically, state-level registry records indicate that Trystan Reese and Collaborate Consulting, LLC have been positioned as the primary trainers, sponsors, and points of contact for programs that correspond directly to Taylor Sprecher's registered copyrights. This report establishes the chain of ownership, analyzes the divergence between federal copyright filings and state registry listings, and outlines the systemic risks and legal implications of this administrative brand encroachment.

Copyright Ownership of the Disputed Educational Portfolios

An analysis of the electronic Copyright Office (eCO) registration history reveals a continuous, multi-year progression of intellectual property development by Taylor Sprecher. Starting in April 2019, Taylor Sprecher began submitting formal copyright applications for training materials, lesson plans, slide decks, and trauma scenarios specifically designed to educate first responders on transgender patient care. These filings reflect Taylor Sprecher's background as a veteran of the United States Navy and an emergency medical technician (EMT) who sought to address systemic gaps in clinical assessments and emergency care protocols.

The copyright registry exhibits a clear pattern of authorship, with multiple applications successfully transitioning to "Closed" status, indicating completed and issued federal copyright registrations. The titles registered under Taylor Sprecher's sole name document the iterative expansion of the curriculum, culminating in comprehensive guides on medical and trauma scenarios.

The continuity of these filings demonstrates that the foundational concepts, scenarios, and structures of the "Emergency Care: Transgender Patients" curriculum are the exclusive, original creation of Taylor Sprecher. This established copyright history serves as prima facie evidence of ownership under federal intellectual property law, confirming that no other individual or corporate entity holds a prior or concurrent claim to the authorship of these written works.

Comparative Analysis of Copyright Registration and OHA Registry Records

While federal records confirm Taylor Sprecher's undivided ownership of the curriculum, state continuing education registries display a different administrative arrangement. In the official database of OHA-approved Cultural Competence Continuing Education trainings, the identical programs and their digital portals are registered to a third-party consulting firm.

Specifically, the OHA registry lists Trystan Reese and Collaborate Consulting, LLC as the lead CE Trainers and primary administrative contacts for "Emergency Care: Transgender/Non-Binary Patients Trauma and Medical Scenerios" and "Taylor's Transgender Patient Awareness". The contact details associated with these registry listings direct all inquiries, registrations, and institutional correspondence to Trystan Reese's professional email address and telephone number.

This structural divergence reveals a significant administrative gap. Although Taylor Sprecher is recognized in secondary fields or on separate, limited registry lines as a contact person, the primary, active continuing education entry lists Trystan Reese as the administrative gatekeeper. This arrangement effectively places Collaborate Consulting, LLC in control of the digital portals 911transedu.net and 911transedu.learnworlds.com, which host Taylor Sprecher's proprietary intellectual property.

Strategic and Legal Risks of Brand Misattribution

Misdirection of Business Leads and Client Acquisitions

By listing Trystan Reese and Collaborate Consulting, LLC as the primary contacts for the

OHA-approved course, the registry systematically diverts prospective business opportunities away from the copyright owner. Healthcare systems, EMS agencies, and educational boards seeking to license this specific curriculum are routed to a third-party consultant rather than the creator. This routing allows Collaborate Consulting, LLC to act as an unauthorized intermediary, capturing high-value institutional accounts and controlling the commercial distribution of Taylor Sprecher's curriculum.

Erosion of Authoritative Credibility and Professional Attribution

The OHA CCCE Registry is a critical resource used by healthcare organizations to verify the credentials and cultural competency of approved trainers. Designating Trystan Reese as the "CE Trainer" for "Emergency Care: Transgender/Non-Binary Patients" creates the incorrect public impression that Trystan Reese possesses the clinical and instructional authority over the coursework. This administrative setup erodes Taylor Sprecher's professional standing as the licensed EMT and subject-matter expert who developed the course to build clinical trust and improve patient survival rates.

Loss of Digital and Domain Governance

The inclusion of the proprietary domains 911transedu.net and 911transedu.learnworlds.com under Collaborate Consulting, LLC's contact row on the registry creates serious technical and legal vulnerabilities. If a third party controls the administrative listings for these delivery portals, they can dictate access terms, monitor student progress, and collect registration fees. This arrangement compromises the owner's operational independence, placing the technical infrastructure of the training programs under external influence.

Forensic Verification of Unrelated Intellectual Property

To ensure a complete and thorough audit, the investigation also evaluated potential naming conflicts and trademarks associated with secondary queries found in search logs.

The "Psychic EMT" Literary Asset

The term "Psychic EMT" refers directly to the published book *Shadows on My Shift: Real-Life Stories of a Psychic EMT*, written by Sherri Lee Devereau and published in 2006 by New River Pr. Sherri Lee Devereau, an intuitive guide and QiGong Master Healer based in Phoenix, Arizona, holds the exclusive copyright and commercial rights to this work. Retail records and bibliographies confirm that this work is a biographical and parapsychological narrative with no professional, clinical, or trademark overlap with Taylor Sprecher's emergency medical education programs.

Regional Emergency Medical Services and Geographical References

Search logs containing references to "Robert Vela," "Oregon," and "EMS" were analyzed to detect any concurrent entity claims or corporate name infringements in the Pacific Northwest. The records indicate that "Robert Vela" refers to Robert Vela High School in Edinburg, Texas, and Dr. Robert Vela, a Texas-based higher education administrator. The search intersection with

Oregon EMS stems from a regional publication that featured a human-interest story about a retired Eugene, Oregon EMT alongside a general sports and academic report on Robert Vela High School. There are no active corporate registrations, trademark filings, or state-approved continuing education programs in Oregon that utilize the name "Robert Vela" in a clinical, educational, or competing capacity.

Compliance and Remediation Recommendations

Petitioning the Oregon Health Authority for Administrative Rectification

The copyright owner must submit a formal, comprehensive petition to the Oregon Health Authority's Equity and Inclusion Division, which oversees the CCCE registry. This petition should include certified copies of the issued United States Copyright Office registrations listed in this report to establish Taylor Sprecher's sole authorship of the underlying curriculum. The petition must request the immediate removal of Trystan Reese and Collaborate Consulting, LLC from all CE Trainer, sponsor, and contact fields for "Emergency Care: Transgender/Non-Binary Patients Trauma and Medical Scenerios" and the associated digital portals. The registry entries must be corrected to list Taylor Sprecher as the sole authorized training director, utilizing the official contact address taylor_sprecher@911transedu.net.

Issuing a Formal Intellectual Property Demand

Legal counsel representing Taylor Sprecher should draft and serve a formal Cease-and-Desist and Intellectual Property Demand to Collaborate Consulting, LLC at their documented business address in Portland, Oregon. This document must establish that Taylor Sprecher has never assigned, transferred, or relinquished the copyright ownership of the educational materials, trauma scenarios, or digital domains to Collaborate Consulting, LLC or Trystan Reese. The demand must require Collaborate Consulting, LLC to immediately withdraw any pending or active applications, registries, or marketing materials that imply ownership, sponsorship, or primary trainer status over Taylor Sprecher's curriculum and portals.

Securing Domain and Hosting Infrastructure

The copyright owner must conduct a thorough audit of the domain registration, hosting agreements, and learning management system (LMS) settings for 911transedu.net and 911transedu.learnworlds.com. It is critical to confirm that the registrar accounts, administrative contact emails, and ownership records for these domains are under the sole control of Taylor Sprecher. Any administrative or technical access previously granted to Trystan Reese or Collaborate Consulting, LLC employees must be revoked immediately to protect student data, proprietary course videos, and payment processing structures.

Consolidating Independent Entity Representation

To prevent future administrative overlap, Taylor's Transgender Patient Awareness LLC should consolidate all educational offerings under its own corporate brand. All active public relations materials, professional podcasts, and course syllabi should explicitly identify Taylor's

Transgender Patient Awareness LLC as the sole owner and developer of the continuing education programs. By enforcing a clear, independent brand identity that excludes any reference to third-party consultants, the owner can preserve the commercial value and professional integrity of these certified educational assets.
