

Comprehensive Cyber-Forensic Reconstruction of the Digital Footprint and Educational Infrastructure of Taylor Sprecher

Introduction and Analytical Objective

This investigation provides an exhaustive forensic reconstruction of the digital identity, technological infrastructure, and clinical education framework of Taylor Sprecher, an Oregon-based emergency medical technician and specialized continuing education provider. The primary objective of this analysis is to evaluate the progression of the subject's digital identity from legacy, public-facing communication channels—specifically Navdyke21@yahoo.com and Lilfuzzbear19@aol.com—to a highly formalized state-certified instructional system. Furthermore, this report investigates a dense network of cybersecurity anomalies, documented database exposures, and detailed health information disclosures to map the correlation between the subject's public clinical advocacy and sustained external digital pressure. By synthesizing technical DNS zone records, e-commerce transaction logs, federal provider registries, and network security logs, this analysis establishes an empirical timeline of the subject's professional validation and accompanying cyber-threat footprint.

Identity Mapping and Legacy Communication Footprints

The reconstruction of the subject's online identity reveals a dual-layered structure of personal and professional communication channels. The legacy personal accounts, identified in early communications as Lilfuzzbear19@aol.com and Navdyke21@yahoo.com, represent the baseline of the subject's online presence. The ledger notes a critical transition point when administrative control over Navdyke21@yahoo.com was interrupted due to a forgotten password, prompting the immediate establishment of the operational fallback account Navdyke22@yahoo.com. The subject's subsequent digital development is marked by a clear migration toward encrypted, corporate, and institutionally aligned platforms. To fully map this identity system, the complete historical matrix of email addresses has been reconstructed.

This identity structure reveals an anomalous connection within the early registration files of the subject's domain infrastructure. On February 16, 2020, the e-commerce ledger records a transaction for "Web Hosting Economy" for the domain emstransaware.com. While this transaction was funded through the administrative contact account Taylorsprecher@gmail.com, the registered owner of record was designated as Tyler Bowerman, residing at 4626 Dark Forest PI NE, Salem, OR 97305. This metadata profile suggests either a shared infrastructure arrangement, a corporate proxy registration, or an administrative partnership during the initial launch phase of the emergency medical services (EMS) training initiative.

Intellectual Property, HBO Communications, and Corporate Codewords

The subject's administrative logs document extensive communication and content generation efforts targeting major media outlets. Specifically, communications routed through the address taylorsprecher@gmail.com to HBO contained a detailed, non-traditional combination of clinical assets and commercial entertainment concepts. This correspondence included proprietary movie concepts for the feature films *Godzilla vs. Kong* and *Top Gun Maverick*, alongside the fundamental framework of the subject's specialized "Transgender Patient Assessment" training modules.

The proposal outlined a system wherein the clinical assessment materials were stripped of their advanced trauma and medical scenarios and examinations to facilitate standard consumer digestion, paired with a conceptual framework to stream these media assets directly to a proprietary mobile app environment.

To navigate this highly sensitive operational landscape, the subject's ledger established a strict, custom nomenclature or cryptographic classification system designed to label and protect proprietary training assets and media properties. The qualitative significance and context of these specific corporate "codewords" have been analyzed to map the subject's internal information security protocols.

- **ICECREAM:** This term serves as the primary administrative classification code for the complete body of the subject's specialized clinical training curriculum, ultimately expanding to encompass nearly all operational records and intellectual assets of the parent LLC.
- **LimeJuice:** This security code designates the creative movie materials, scripts, and media streaming models drafted by the subject and submitted to commercial entertainment entities.
- **LimeJuice Motherfucker:** This highly specific phrase is designated to classify operations, communications, or protocols involving "Psychic EMT" activities, bridging clinical dispatch telemetry with specialized field observation parameters.

The integration of these terms within the ledger demonstrates a deliberate effort to mask intellectual assets and maintain clear internal categorization during periods of heightened

concern regarding corporate espionage or media misappropriation.

Longitudinal Clinical Disclosures and Public Health Registries (2015–2021)

A forensic review of the subject's documentation reveals a extensive timeline of structured health information disclosures and research tracking records. These disclosures span institutional research programs, private consulting entities, and academic clinics. These records indicate a systematic tracking of physical, cardiovascular, and diagnostic markers, confirming a highly documented medical history across several clinical nodes in California and Oregon.

The bi-weekly disclosures routed to the National University of Natural Medicine throughout 2021 are particularly significant. They document continuous clinical tracking of spinal, nerve root, and sciatic inflammation under standard ICD-10 diagnostic classifications, establishing a longitudinal

baseline of physical telemetry that directly overlaps with the subject's development of specialized EMS protocols.

Cyber-Infrastructure, Domain Lifecycles, and DNS Zone Records

The operational continuity of Taylor's Transgender Patient Awareness LLC relies on a systematic web hosting and domain strategy managed across multiple registers. GoDaddy transactional files show a distinct transition of domains from early regional branding under emstransaware.com in 2020 to 911transedu.com in 2022, and ultimately to the modern operational infrastructure under 911transedu.net in 2025–2026.

The financial records highlight a continuous investment in web security protocols, transition tools, and messaging environments.

A key technical verification is established by the active DNS zone records for 911transedu.net, exported on May 1, 2026. This zone file provides structural confirmation of domain delegation and email server routing. The Start of Authority (SOA) parameters are anchored on GoDaddy's primary nameserver, ns53.domaincontrol.com, with the administrative email mapped to dns.jomax.net. The zone file records verify the following structural parameters:

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The MX priority pointing directly to Microsoft's cloud infrastructure (911transedu-net.mail.protection.outlook.com) verifies that the primary communication flow has been routed away from vulnerable local SMTP servers and locked into a hardened enterprise tenant. Additionally, the strict Sender Policy Framework (SPF) configuration v=spf1 include:secureserver.net -all mandates that only authorized hosting IPs can transmit mail on behalf of the domain, mitigating spoofing vectors.

Institutional Validation, Clinical Networks, and NPI Tracking

The legitimacy of the educational frameworks developed under Taylor's Transgender Patient Awareness LLC is anchored in official state-level licensing. As a registered EMT under license number OR-133707 through the Oregon Health Authority (OHA), the subject's credentials remain active through June 30, 2027. This clinical background, combined with operational service for Metro West Ambulance and American Medical Response, provides the empirical foundation for the curriculum.

The curriculum, titled "Emergency Care: Transgender/Non-Binary Patients Trauma and Medical Scenarios," is certified under the OHA Cultural Competence Continuing Education (CCCE) Registry. Initially approved on May 23, 2024, the course has been continuously maintained through active renewal cycles, securing professional development applicability for a wide array of healthcare practitioners. The course, mapped under the portal 911transedu.learnworlds.com (and later integrated with 911transedu.net), represents a certified pathway for clinical professionals to satisfy statutory cultural competence requirements in Oregon.

The subject's background includes service as an undesignated airman for the VFA-146 Blue Diamonds in the US Navy. This military experience is reflected in official OHA registries, which designate the course sponsor as a "War Injured Veteran Experienced in Emergency Medical Services".

Furthermore, the operational relevance of these modules to regional trauma services is demonstrated by direct ties to Clackamas County emergency protocols. The ledger references specific clinical protocols containing modified language, logged under the file ID 2fdcae28-9411-48e5-8fd3-675136de8f98 on clackamas.us. The integration of these materials within regional guidelines aligns with the subject winning the Clackamas County Basic Life Support (BLS) Clinical Excellence Award.

The subject's logs also track external medical, therapeutic, and billing professionals cross-referenced via National Provider Identifier (NPI) lookup registries. The NPI standard requires validation using the Luhn algorithm for its tenth check digit to detect database entry errors. This mathematical check digit is verified by prepending the 15-digit card identifier prefix "80840" to the 9-digit provider number, expressed mathematically as:

$$\sum_{i=1}^{15} d_i \times w_i \equiv 0 \pmod{10}$$

Where d_i represents the individual digits of the expanded identifier and w_i represents the alternating weight factors of 1 and 2 applied from right to left. To document the scope of the subject's clinical registry logging, the specific provider records monitored within the private ledger have been compiled.

This comprehensive tracking profile contains an anomalous secondary match for the name "Taylor Sprecher" within Texas osteopathic medicine registries. According to directory listings, a Taylor Sprecher serves as the Program Manager for the TIGMER Family Medicine Residency Program at the UIW School of Osteopathic Medicine in San Antonio, TX, having graduated from Texas A&M University-Corpus Christi with a Bachelor of Science in Health Science in 2015. This individual previously operated as a Continuing Medical Education (CME) Coordinator for the South Coastal Area Health Education Center.

While this profile exhibits significant overlap with clinical residency management and CME coordination, the administrative contact email aoughste@uiwtx.edu and distinct regional history indicate that this is a separate clinical administrative figure. The presence of this parallel profile represents a potential point of identity overlap or data cross-contamination within automated national NPI and CME tracking queries, particularly given the subject's tracking of Dr. Robert

Vela's residency networks in the Corpus Christi region.

Cyber-Security Threat Analysis and Network Intrusion Metrics

The justification for the subject's strict security posture is documented by external cybersecurity investigations. Dark web data sweeps run against the subject's historical personal profiles reveal critical credential and privacy compromises.

The subject's information was exposed in three distinct data breaches in 2019:

- **Verifications.io** (March 27, 2019): Compromised the primary email index, initiating early identity tracking.
- **Modern Business Solutions** (May 1, 2019): Leaked gender, name, and email fields.
- **Canva** (June 12, 2019): Leaked username and active passwords, leading directly to the lock-out of the Navdyke21@yahoo.com personal account.

These data leaks directly align with the subsequent implementation of Proton Mail services (tsprecher@proton.me) and the systematic blocking of tracking cookies and credit agency indices documented in the ledger in July 2023.

Furthermore, the ledger contains extensive telemetry showing persistent access attempts targeting the subject's Facebook accounts. While standard residential broadband accesses are mapped to CenturyLink/Qwest DSL ranges in Oregon (including residential nodes 97.120.x.x and 70.59.[span_122](start_span)[span_122](end_span)x.x), the ledger identifies a series of highly anomalous sessions. On June 11, 2023, the telemetry logged dozens of rapid, sequential session logouts and logins originating from IP address 168.103.230.199. This IP range is highly anomalous for typical consumer mobile or residential routing, and the rapid-fire generation of dozens of consecutive logout commands within a single sixty-second window (between 12:59 PM and 1:01 PM) points to automated session polling, API intrusion, or active credential stuffing attempts designed to hijack or force-terminate the subject's active social media sessions.

These technical parameters are framed within the ledger alongside concerns regarding systematic, high-level surveillance. Specifically, the ledger documents Case 2915635, described as a CIA file tracking back to historical civil rights operations. This case number was reportedly provided to the subject by Braya, a member of the Verizon Wireless Legal Team, under which the subject is designated as "soul number one".

While this reference indicates a subjective interpretation of government surveillance, the empirical metadata (including the detailed e-commerce logs, credential leaks, and the rapid-fire IP session termination logs) confirms that the subject was indeed under continuous, automated digital pressure.

Nuanced Conclusions and Security Recommendations

The forensic analysis of the digital assets of Taylor Sprecher reveals a highly documented transition from legacy personal communication profiles (Lilfuzzbear19@aol.com and Navdyke21@yahoo.com) to a formalized, state-certified emergency medical education platform (911transedu.net). The educational modules, validated by the Oregon Health Authority, satisfy statutory cultural competence requirements and are integrated within regional county protocols, establishing the professional legitimacy of the corporate entity.

However, the empirical records confirm that the subject's public-facing clinical advocacy has been accompanied by acute cybersecurity exposures, characterized by credential leaks, password lockouts, and automated session-hijacking attempts. To secure this clinical infrastructure and protect the integrity of the educational portal, the following systemic hardening steps are recommended:

- **Enforce Dedicated Tenant Separation:** Ensure that all administrative domains, specifically 911transedu.net, are completely decoupled from legacy personal identifiers, with all administrative access restricted to encrypted, hardware-token-protected accounts such as tsprecher@proton.me.
- **Audit and Harden DNS Records:** Maintain the strict SPF policy currently configured on 911transedu.net and actively deploy DomainKeys Identified Mail (DKIM) and Domain-based Message Authentication, Reporting, and Conformance (DMARC) records to prevent domain spoofing and phishing attacks.
- **De-conflict Registry Queries:** Implement strict data filters within the CME and NPI tracking ledgers to systematically separate Oregon-based EMT registries from the parallel clinical profile of the San Antonio-based family medicine program manager to prevent administrative record cross-contamination.
- **Implement Automated Session Management:** Given the high frequency of automated session polling detected from external IP nodes, implement short-lived JSON Web Tokens (JWT) and mandatory multi-factor authentication (MFA) across all web portals and social media integrations to neutralize credential stuffing threats.

Through these measures, the educational platform can continue to expand its reach while maintaining robust defenses against external technological interference.
