







TROUT TREK





STRONGER TOGETHER LET'S FISH RESPONSIBLY

In alignment with Keep Fish Wet and iFishiBelong, we're doubling down on awareness and advocacy as we head into the hottest stretch of the year, when catch-and-release fishing can do more harm than good. High water temperatures can be deadly for fish, even when released, and now's the time to pay close attention.

That's why we're backing Keep Fish Wet's "No Fish Dry July" campaign, which challenges anglers to leave fish in the water and instead capture the real moments of scenery, stories, and experiences that make summer fishing unforgettable. It's not about skipping the cast, it's about showing up smarter.

Their science-backed resources break down how even small changes in how we catch, handle, and release fish can dramatically improve survival and recovery. Best practices don't just protect fish, they keep the ecosystem thriving, and the sport sustainable for everyone. **Community, conservation, and action. Let's lead with intention. 


