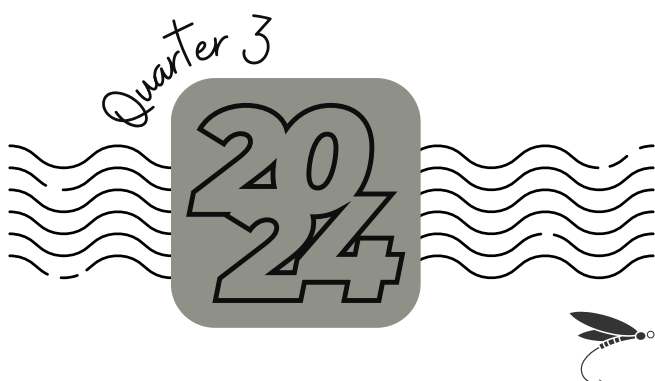

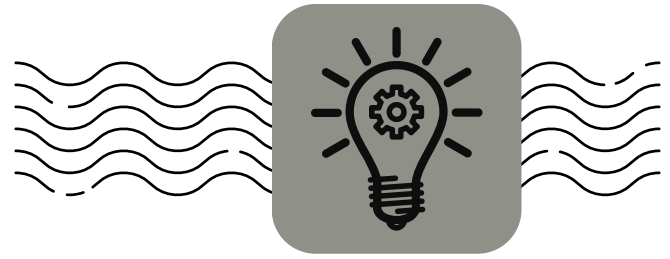

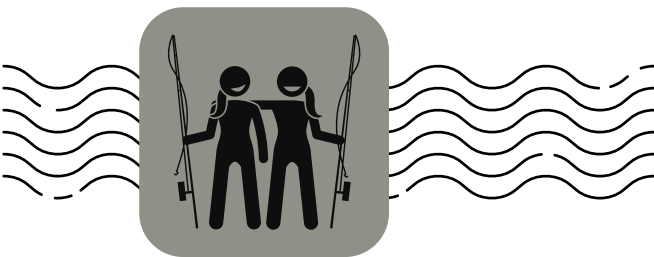


ANNUAL RETREAT

SURVEY RESULTS

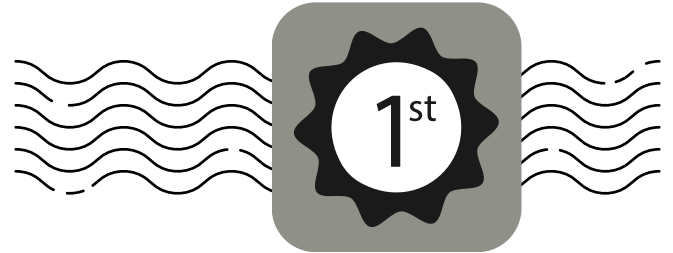
