I hope 2025 was good for you and yours, and 2026 is off to a great start. I hope you enjoy the KMB 123 Community Foundation impact report, and you can see just some of the lasting results that you, the supporters of our cause, have helped to contribute to.

We have chosen to call it an **IMPACT REPORT** instead of a newsletter for a reason. The reason is simply that we have created a true impact with continued dedication from the people reading this, our supporters. Without YOU, none of the help we provide could be possible. We have continued to grow from our inception in mid-2024, and we have plans to continue that trajectory as our support grows.

Some personal highlights for me in 2025 were:

- Our ability to help grow the **Camp Hope for Kids** capacity from 27 kids in 2024 to 40 kids in 2025. Camp Hope is a camp specifically designed to help grieving children navigate the sudden loss of a loved one.
- KMB's ability to step in and assist **The Susquehanna County Interfaith** provide 400 Christmas gifts to children in 2025. For many local children, these are the only Christmas gifts that they may receive during the holiday season.
- Our newest, and probably most far-reaching opportunity that YOU, our supporters, helped us accomplish was the overwhelming **donations to our local food banks**. What started off as an idea to provide a little relief for a few foodbanks turned into KMB 123 providing enough goods to stock 3 foodbanks during their most pressing time of need. This initiative gained so much support that it has allowed us to continue to provide items as needed through the brutally cold winter months and into the spring. This came at a very opportune time as struggling families faced other financial burdens due to the increase in energy costs everyone has absorbed in late '25 and early '26.

In closing, I'd just like you to know that on behalf of the entire KMB 123 family, I am in your debt for your continued support, and I truly hope to be able to write many more of these **IMPACT REPORTS**.

COMMUNITY IMPACT



Gifts designated for children in our community included support for Camp Hope for Kids. In addition, a \$5,000 contribution helped provide countless pairs of shoes, backpacks, and essential school supplies to students across our local school districts. While a new pair of sneakers may be something many take for granted, our goal was to ensure that as many children as possible could return to school feeling confident and prepared with a new pair of shoes.

This year we also became aware that many students lacked access to essential hygiene products, daily necessities, and laundry supplies. In partnership with the Susquehanna Community School District, we helped cover the costs of hygiene and laundry supplies for students to access throughout the year. Additionally, our gift helped with the costs of installing a washer and dryer in the space. The newly established Student Resource Center will enhance attendance, boost self-confidence, and contribute to the overall success of students across the district.



In 2025, it became clear to all of us that food disparity in our area is both real and prevalent. Our board introduced what we thought would be a small giving challenge we introduced as ♡ Give Back. Honor Kelly. Help Feed Our Community. ♡ and WOW, did you show up in an incredible way. Because of your generosity and support, we were able to make significant food donations to families throughout our community.



With your support in 2025, we were able to partner with several local nonprofits to make an even bigger impact in our community.

This past year we joined forces with our friends at Susquehanna County Interfaith & the Giddy-Up Fund. In addition, we partnered with the Kevin Class Golf Tournament to donate to the Montrose Minute Men EMS. We couldn't have done any of this without you.

Kelly Bush left a legacy of heartfelt contributions to our community. In honor of that legacy, we established a scholarship at Montrose Area High School in 2025. These scholarships are awarded to graduating seniors who have demonstrated the character and commitment to carry on Kelly's mission of bettering our community.

In 2025, your support helped us award five recipients, a legacy Kelly would be proud of.

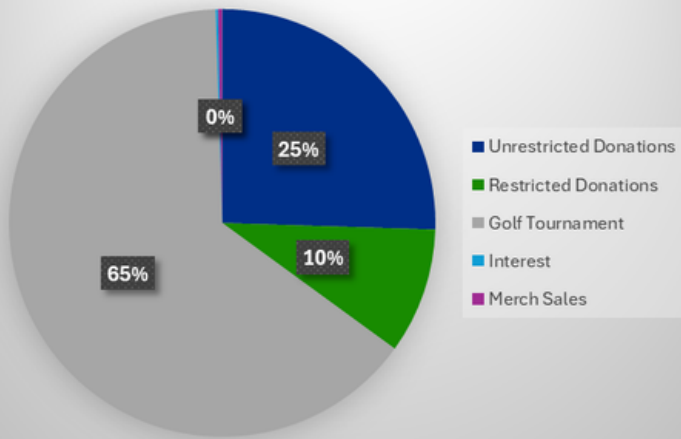


The second annual Kelly Bush Memorial Basketball Tournament was held on December 29, 2025 at Montrose Area High School.

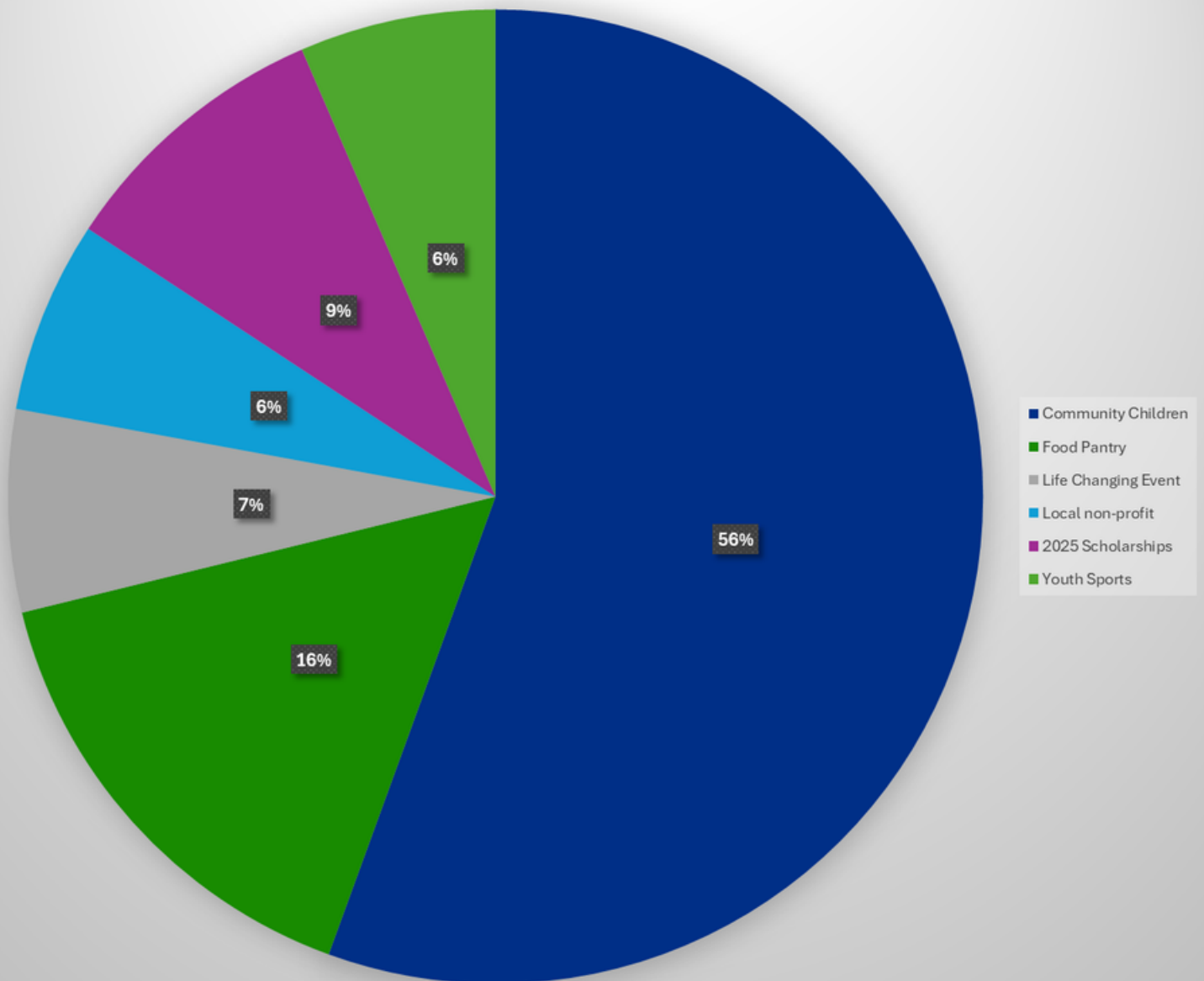
