ELIGIBILITY & APPLICATION

- 1 Any student <u>RESIDING in</u> or <u>SCHOOLED in</u>: Calhoun, Fairfield, Kershaw, Lexington, Newberry, Orangeburg, Richland, or Saluda County is eligible to compete. Teachers are <u>not</u> required to be a member of either music club (Eau Claire Music Club or Columbia Afternoon Music Club).
- 2. Competition is limited to students in grade 6 through College Junior. AGE LIMIT IS 25!
- 3. Students may enter up to <u>TWO Categories</u>, but may not be chosen a winner in the <u>same Category</u> in the <u>same Division</u> for 2 consecutive years. <u>An application and fee are required for each category</u>.
- 4. An entering student must be in at least his/her second year of study.
- 5. Application forms may be obtained from the scholarship chair and must be postmarked by Jan. 20, 2024.
- 6. A registration fee of \$20.00 must accompany each application. Make check payable to the "Music Clubs Scholarship Fund."
- 7. **NEW There is only 1 choice for providing MUSIC for the JUDGES:** Create a pdf of the music, per selection, & email with the Performance Links to: brendapd1949@gmail.com by Jan. 20.

CATEGORIES & DIVISIONS/PAYMENT OF SCHOLARSHIPS

1. Piano Solo (4 Divisions): Intermediate (gr.6-8); Secondary (gr.9-11); Senior (gr.12); Collegiate (Freshman-Junior)

One scholarship of \$200 will be awarded in Intermediate; \$300 in Secondary; \$400 in Senior; \$500 in Collegiate.

2. Piano Concerto (3 Divisions): Intermediate (gr.6-8); Secondary (gr.9-11); Senior (gr.12)

One scholarship of: \$200 - Intermediate; \$300 - Secondary; \$400 - Senior.

NOTE: Up to FIVE Rice Music House Scholarships of \$150 each will be awarded in any Division of Piano.

3. Voice (2 Divisions): Senior (gr. 12); Collegiate (Freshman-Junior) One scholarship of: \$400 - Senior; \$500 - Collegiate

4. Strings/ (4 Divisions): Intermediate (gr. 6-8); Secondary (gr. 9-11); Senior (gr. 12); Collegiate (Freshman-Junior)

Classical Guitar One scholarship of: \$200 - Intermediate; \$300 - Secondary; \$400 - Senior; \$500 - Collegiate

5. Brass/Woodwinds/ (4 Divisions): Intermediate (gr. 6-8); Secondary (gr. 9-11); Senior (gr. 12); Collegiate (Freshman-Junior)

Percussion One scholarship of: \$200 - Intermediate; \$300 – Secondary; \$400 - Senior; \$500 - Collegiate

6. Organ Organists may contact Brenda Dean. Location of auditions: TBA

PREPARATION OF STUDENTS

- 1. Music chosen for audition shall be selected from acceptable recital and teaching literature. Entrants must have at least 2 contrasting pieces. Only 1 movement is required for concerti.
- 2. Maximum playing time in the audition for Intermediate Divisions, (Solo and Piano Concerto), is **8 minutes**. Secondary, Senior & Collegiate Divisions, (Solo and Piano Concerto), **preferably 10 minutes or less/max of 15 minutes**.
- 3. Memorization is required in all piano and voice divisions. Other divisions may use music scores.
- 4. Instrumental/Vocal candidates must provide an accompanist. Teachers may accompany.

- 1. Subject title of email: STUDENT 1st NAME, LAST INITIAL; GRADE in school; CATEGORY EX. JOHN S 7 PIANO SOLO
- 2. Within the body of the email include: (NO LAST NAME, NO TEACHER NAME) <u>Performance Links</u>; <u>Music pdfs</u>; <u>SAME info from Subject Title</u>; and specific INSTRUMENT.
- 3. Pianists: Record full sideview showing hands, feet, & music stand area. Vocalists: Front view. Others: Sideview, if using music

JUDGES

- 1. Usually: 1 judge Strings; 1 judge Brass/WW/Percussion; 2-3 judges Piano, 1 judge Voice, 1 judge Organ, if applicable.
- 2. Judges will write critiques of the performance, addressing musical skills, appropriate interpretation, style, etc.
- 3. Completed Critiques will be emailed to teachers.
- 4. Awards will be given at the discretion of the judge and available funding.
- 5. Award Ceremony will follow the WINNERS RECITAL. A VIRTUAL WINNERS PROGRAM with performance links will be emailed to a large population sometime in April. PLEASE KEEP the YOUTUBE PERFORMANCE LINKS ACTIVE through JUNE 1.
