

IMPORTANT RECITAL NOTES

DRESS REHEARSAL – Saturday, May 26, 2018 – 12:30pm

(in cafeteria of North Grenville District High School, 2605 Concession Rd.)

- Pre-Ballet (Teacups) can arrive by **12:15pm** to get into their costumes.
- All other dancers should arrive at **11:30 AM**. We will start the actual stage rehearsal at 12:30pm.
- When dancers arrive they should put their costumes on and sit **quietly** in the chairs in front of the stage. Please help your child into their costume.
- Hair should be up away from face in a bun (unless otherwise specified by Nancy).
- **Do not eat with your costume on.**
- **No chewing gum.**
- Once their dance has been done their costumes should be placed **neatly** in their change room. Costumes remain in the High School over night.
- We will rehearse bows part way through the rehearsal so that the young children can go home after their dance has been practiced.
- Bring costume and ticket money if not already done so.
- Makeup is not necessary for the dress rehearsal. If you wish to practice this is fine.
- Ballet IV and the Adult ballet classes will use the room adjacent to the stage as a change room
- Pre-Ballet (Teacups) & Ballet II (Rose Petals) classes will use the Girls Change Room.
- **All female students should have clean white tights and their pink ballet slippers.** –Boys black ballet slippers.

PERFORMANCE Sunday, May 27, 2018 – 2:00 PM

(in cafeteria of North Grenville District High School, 2605 Concession Rd.)

- Approximate length 90 minutes with 10 minute intermission.
- All dancers should arrive by **1:00 PM** with their hair securely in place and make up on.
- Remove all jewelry and put in a safe place. We are not responsible for lost or stolen articles.
- **NO CHEWING GUM.**
- **Do not eat with your costume on.**
- There will be a 10 minute intermission part way through the show. Please keep dancers in their costume for bows at the end of the show.
- The Pre-Ballet (Teacups) will stay with parents in audience for first half of show. **Please bring them back stage during intermission.** When they finish their dance two girls (“Mrs. Potts & Chip”) will bring them to audience so they can sit with parents till end of show.
- All dancers will be called back on stage after the show for their bows as practiced at the dress rehearsal. They will be called to come up from the audience by the stairs at the left side of the stage.
- Costumes may be taken home **after** the performance.
- **Most importantly dancers should smile, have fun and enjoy the experience of performing on stage.**
- Volunteers may be required for take down of backdrop, chairs and for clean up.
- **All students should have clean white tights and their pink ballet slippers.** –Boys black ballet slippers.
