## IMPORTANT RECITAL NOTES

## DRESS REHEARSAL - Saturday, June 1, 2024-11:30pm

(in cafeteria of North Grenville District High School, 2605 Concession Rd.)

- We will start the rehearsal with the Saturday Pre-Ballet I, II & Ballet I classes and the sequence that the 'Cardinals' are involved in. Then we will practice bows. This way the younger children classes can go home early by about 12:30 hopefully or a bit sooner.
- Please arrive in time to be ready to go on stage by 11:30am.
- When dancers arrive they should put their costumes on and sit quietly in the chairs in front of the stage. Please help your child into their costume.
- Hair should be up away from face in a bun (unless otherwise specified by Nancy).
- Do not eat with your costume on.
- No chewing gum.
- Once their dance has been done their costumes should be placed **neatly** in their change room. Costumes remain in the High School over night.
- Bring costume and ticket money if not already done so.
- Makeup is not necessary for the dress rehearsal. If you wish to practice this is fine.
- Pre-Ballet I (Ladybugs), Pre-Ballet II (Deer) & Ballet I (Cardinals) will use the Girls Change Room
- Ballet IV & Adults will use the music room adjacent to the stage as a change room (note you can also use the Girls and/or the Boys change room)
- All students should have <u>clean white tights and their pink</u> <u>ballet slippers.</u>

## PERFORMANCE Sunday, June 2, 2024 – 2:00 PM

(in cafeteria of North Grenville District High School, 2605 Concession Rd.)

- Approximate length 90 minutes with 10 minute intermission.
- All dancers should arrive by <u>1:30 PM</u> with their hair securely in place and make up on.
- Remove all jewelry and put in a safe place. We are not responsible for lost or stolen articles.
- NO CHEWING GUM.
- Do not eat with your costume on.
- There will be a 10 minute intermission part way through the show. Please keep dancers in their costume for bows at the end of the show.
- Pre-Ballet I (Ladybugs), Pre-Ballet II (Deer) & Ballet I (Cardinals)
  will remain backstage until they go on. When they finish their
  dance an older girl will help them down the stairs on right side
  of stage. Please collect your dancer at this time.
- All dancers will be called back on stage after the show for their bows as practiced at the dress rehearsal. They will be called to come up from the audience by the stairs at the left side of the stage.
- Costumes may be taken home after the performance.
- Most importantly dancers should smile, have fun and enjoy the experience of performing on stage.
- Volunteers may be required for take down of backdrop, chairs and for clean up.
- All students should have <u>clean white tights and their pink</u> <u>ballet slippers.</u>
