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Summary of Qualifications

Dra. Serina Payan Hazelwood (she/her/ella) is a queer, detribalized-Indigenous Chicana scholar, holistic sexuality educator, AASECT Certified Sexuality Educator and CE Provider, and an AASECT Supervisor in Training. She earned her PhD in Sustainability Education at Prescott College. Her dissertation, *Re-Animating Chingonisma: Creating Indigenous Elsewheres Through Liberatory Praxis*, re-animates Chingonisma as a Body of Knowledge grounded in ceremony, memory, and ancestral resilience. Guided by the Mexica cosmology of the Nahui Ollin, the Nopal Phases, and the Table of Power, her research confronts the violence of the Ivory Tower that represents the systems of colonialism and enacts relational accountability, spirit restoration, and cultural sovereignty..

As founder of *The Elsewheres*, she cultivates intentionally exclusive micro-spaces for transformative education rooted in decolonial praxis, Indigenous futurities, and community-centered healing. Her work integrates anti- and decolonial, queer, and feminist of-color methodologies, creating culturally responsible learning environments that emphasize liberation, resilience, and sustainability.

Her published contributions include *Re-Animating Chingonisma: Creating Indigenous Elsewheres Through Liberatory Praxis* (2025), *U.S. Parks and Protected Area Power Structures: From Historic Policies to Indigenous Futurities (Earth Stewardship, 2025)*, and *Reimagining U.S. Federal Land Management Through Decolonization and Indigenous Value Systems (Journal of Park and Recreation Administration, 2022)*.
