At Time 2 Shine, we understand the importance of allowing children to express themselves through their clothing. However, it is crucial that when they come to sessions they are dressed appropriately for the activities.

We do not mind what you wear as long as it is practical and isn't going to hinder your engagement or safety.

At no point must members wear socks without shoes on as this can cause serious injuries to the participants.

Clothing must be appropriate. We have uniform that you can purchase of Time 2 Shine leggings and a T-shirt. This is not compulsory and at no point will Time 2 Shine enforce any paid clothing.

We ask that if you are wearing skirts that you have shorts underneath to respect your own dignity and ensure that others are also respected.

Make sure that whatever you choose to wear you are ready to engage and enjoy the sessions you are attending.
