#### • PROMOTIONS CRITERIA/BEVORDERINGS KRITERIA,

- which will be a working document parallel to the Constitution.
- This document will list the exact criteria for evaluations and promotions.
- This document will be compiled by the Executive Committee, constantly bringing it up to date.

# 1) QUALIFICATION PROCESS

RHJA of SA to present practical courses in judging for interested candidates to attend.

The Ring Stewards Course and Examination will form part of the qualification process. Candidate Judges will need to attend the course and write the examination. This will replace the Ring Routine segment.

Course material may be made available to candidates prior to practical courses.

Candidates may elect to attend various courses and write the specific examination at different times. Examinations may also be taken remotely or on line.

Candidate Judge must complete the examinations and pass prior to moving on to the Practical Assessment

# 2) QUALIFICATION PROGRAMMES/SYSEMS

Two different programmes/systems will be used.

1. APP Reporting (online programme)

This is an online APP that is sent to the Senior Judge/s at a show where Candidate or Junior Judges is then evaluated and reported on by said Senor/s. The Reporting APP is sent directly to the secretary of the Association. No paper work.

2. Evaluation (excel programme)

This is an evaluation system against the outcome of the final card/s. The Candidate or Junior Judges cards are entered on the programme and then evaluated independently.

# 3) QUALIFYING SHOWS

# **Regional Show and Club Shows**

Both Regional Shows and Club Shows are used for reporting and evaluation of candidate and junior judges.

Senior Judges report App and Evaluation against the outcome of the card.

Saddlebred Association of SA show criteria is currently 80 horses for a regional show and 30 for a club show.

# SANESA

Both Regional and National SANESA shows are used towards the qualification of candidate and junior judges

SANESA score sheets and SANESA and confirmation letter of judges.

# 1) CRITERIA FOR PROMOTION

# Candidate:

REGIONAL, CLUB OR SANESA REGIONAL/NATIONALS FROM INSIDE THE RING (may be any combination)

- Candidate to judge the entire show.
- Can be a combination of Regional and Club Shows

- If the Regional Show does not have at least 80 Saddle Horses then the Candidate may be asked to do a 4<sup>th</sup> show.
- At least one of the shows must be outside of the candidates own Region. (Province of Residency)
- The Senior Judge then to send in the APP report. If there are two Senior Judges both may hand in a report. It will only be counted as 1 show for the Candidate.

# Promotion from Candidate to Junior

- Has to Pass Written Exam with 60% or above in each subject.
- A minimum of 3 Positive Reports coming from 3 different shows (65% and above)
- Candidates Card Evaluated against the Outcome of the Class (Above 55%)

# Junior:

REGIONAL, CLUB OR SANESA NATIONALS FROM INSIDE THE RING (may be any combination)

- Junior Judge to judge the entire show.
- If the Regional Show does not have at least 80 Saddle Horses then the Junior Judge may be asked to do a 4<sup>rd</sup> show.
- At least one of the shows must be outside of the Junior Judges own Region. (Province of Residency)
- The Senior Judge then to send in the APP report. If there are two Senior Judges both may send in a report. This will only be counted as 1 show for the Junior Judge.

#### Promotion from Junior to Senior

- A minimum of 3 Positive Reports coming from 3 different shows (70% and above)
- Junior Judges Card Evaluated against the Outcome of the Class (Above 60%)
