Candidate Judges:

A new strategy to assist Candidate Judges at shows to get real time practical input from senior judges has been implemented. The trial run took place at Uniondale Show during November 2020 with great results. The candidate/s judge a few of the classes from outside the arena with a senior judge to give live time comment. The class can be discussed while in progress and thus give real time instruction and opinions. The normal process where the candidate/s perform the duties from inside the arena still forms part of the training.

Constitution:

We are revising the Constitution and preparing an Evaluation Criteria Document which will be a separate document from the Constitution. This will make the Constitution much more stream lined and effective in addressing the normal constitution issues. To be presented for consideration at the 2021 AGM

Evaluation Criteria:

The old 'Rating System" will be replaced by this Evaluation Criteria Document. The new Evaluation Concept will be an electronic offering in order to manage effective quality control and transparency.

Specialist Saddle Seat Equitation Qualification:

With a great deal riding (excuse the pun) on the judging of Trials for National Team selection, International competitions, Champion of Champions and the SANESA Provincial Colours, we feel that it is necessary to offer a specialist form of qualification for this category.

A more comprehensive qualification will be offered for voluntary sign up by our members. This will include more tutorial and training opportunities along with questionnaires to keep our judges up to date and fully informed.

These "Specialist" Equitation Judges may then be accessed for the above mentioned Saddle Seat Equitation competitions and shows.

Juvenile Judges Programme:

We are planning on offering young riders the opportunity to judge a show as a practical experience via the SANESA competitions. These children will attend a short presentation on what to look for and what to expect, along with how to fill in a judges' card. They will then have the opportunity to judge the Supporters Classes at these shows.

There will be a prize for the closest to the class outcome! A great way to involve younger riders and give them a feel of what it is all about to stand in the ring.

This programme will roll out with the SANESA shows, once we have confirmation on when and where these will be presented.
