## PRESIDENT'S REPORT & NEW RULES / PRESIDENTSVERSLAG EN NUWE REËLS

Eerstens wil ek graag my komitee bedank vir hul bystand en hul goeie oordeel met, en in ons vergaderings - hul eerlikheid en besondere ywer om die Vereniging op 'n eerbare wyse te bestuur, 'n Groot dank aan ons Sekretaresse Mej Kaplan wat net RBV eet slaap en drink - op haar senuwees raak en almal om haar in 'n harwar stuur. Verskoon my laaste opmerking want ek weet dit is net om alles in detail te wil reg hê vir ons vereniging en 'n besonder om te sien na ons finansies waarvoor sy beslis baie bekwaam is. Ek wil ook ons filiaal die Beampies Ver., onder Mnr Jackie van Renen bedank vir hulle hoë gehalte werk wat hulle verrig op ons skoubane en vir al die besondere hulp wat hulle aan beoordelaars en verenigings verleen op ons groot skoue en ander. Min erkenning word aan hierdie mense gegee. Dink net hoe vlot ons skoue met hul onbaatsugtelike take as versameelperk beampies - waar hul soms nie eers die skou te siene kry nie - maar tog alles reg hanteer en in orde kry, nie net vir die vertoner nie, of beoordelaar nie, maar vir die toeskouer ook.

In conjunction with Graaff-Reinet Show, we held a very interesting Equitation Course with an American Judge and Instructor on Saddle Seat equitation. We also had Mr Beresford Manning instructing on Standard Seat Equitation. It was an exceptional course as far as instruction was concerned with a lot of time and thought put into it, but alas and very disappointingly poorly attended by our judges who wished for such tuition and refreshment of knowledge. Sadly disappointing was the financial loss the RHJA suffered due to the poor attendance of our judges, which had to carry the expenses incurred by the importation of the American Instructor, whom they proposed to have come out to do the necessary. It is therefore obvious that we cannot afford instruction from abroad in the future. Nevertheless I wish to state emphatically that our exhibitors and children doing equitation have improved beyond recognition, which shows that the tuition received by them was not in vain - especially with regard to the participants who competed against the International teams. The young girls from America most definitely did enthral us and enlivened the enthusiasm of our participants. Thanks to our Amateur Society for making this competition possible.

Ons het verlede maand 'n baie geslaagde beoordelaars eksamen gehou te Bloemfontein. Dit was verblydend om te sien hoeveel kinders hierdie eksamen kom aflê het. Ek hoop dat diegene wat moontlik nie geslaag het nie, hul kennis sal verbreed, die regte kursusse sal bywoon en weer hul kennis kom toets in die toekoms. Ons toekoms hang van die jeug af en natuurlik hoe goed hulle goeie voorligting kan absorbeer.

Hier wil ek graag diegene wat betrokke was met die verskaffing van die nodige om hierdie eksamens te hou baie te bedank, ons eksaminators en Mej kaplan wat ons byna om die draai gehad het, en natuurlik dankie aan Pierre Hanekom vir sy aandeel hierin. After all is said and done it still remains a smack in the face for our Judges' Assoc, when we are overlooked or shifted aside to make place for American judges who have to judge our major shows. I do not deny that we do learn from them, but why should we sacrifice our individuality as S.Africans to show and judge as we deem fit, to be belittled by a few exhibitors dissatisfied because they did not win enough prizes under S.A. judges, astounding as it may seem, I believe the results of the Shows have been shoved into a computer to assess which S.A. judges did not place certain horses. How small can we become when this becomes practice. Is there a necessity to judge or should the computer decide?

South Africans are elected by a majority vote and when they are duly appointed to adjudicate, are promptly shot down because some individuals could not make the tie. Do we do the same with American judges appointed in the same way and possibly tie the horses exactly as our judges did? In any case horses perform differently at different shows. Having stated this who can say which are the better judges - they are all in any case appointed by us.

It is mostly the chap on the side line who is to be blamed for these misconceptions. People without knowledge who "suck up" to unfortunate losers and spin the weirdest incorrect stories about judges just to be recognised as a knowledgeable chap. I make a plea to our horse lovers to disregard these types. Let them have their dreams and illusions - or should I say let them rather dream because then their eyes are closed but with illusions they are unfortunately open.

Noudat ek ter verdediging van ons S.A. beoordelaars gepraat het, wil ek hulle tog aanmaan om nie hul goeie reputasie te laat skipbreuk ly deur onoorloofde stories, of handeling maar hul daarteen te verdedig en waar hul 'n fout kon begaan het wat heel menslik is, dit dan ruitelik te erken. Niemand word meer beoordeel deur ander dan die beoordelaar nie, dus moet daar nie beywer word om roem of, aangesien nie na eer om regtigheid te laat geskied aan die perd van S.A. in die skouring en oral.

Na dié lang relaas wil ek u verseker dat ek die toekoms van hierdie vereniging net in 'n rooskleurigelik sien en wil sien u is een en almal deel in die vereniging se toekoms - laat ons dus ons identiteit behou en net die beste verlang.

Daar sal vanjaar 'n kort kursus gehou word. Die inkomende komitee sal bepaal waar dit gehou word, afhangende van waar die meeste aansoeke kom. —Charl van den Heever.

### A EXISTING RULES TO BE IMPLEMENTED

- i. Two Seniors and one Junior to Judge Sire Rating Shows unless it is IMPOSSIBLE to locate a Junior. (With Blm. excluded.)  
The Change in Constitution was proposed by Mr Mac Murdoch at the AGM 1981, was ratified 1982 and again 1983; and was AGAIN PASSED UNANIMOUSLY at both RHJA & SHBS AGMs this year.
- ii E2(d) DUTIES OF STEWARD (Rule Book page 76)  
As a guide to Stewards in dealing with maladjustment of tails, *anything that is unsightly, or that spoils the spectacle of the Show is reason for action,*

Unanimously accepted that RHSA have the right to disqualify; also passed SHBS.

**B NEW RULES**

1. All Senior Judges who request self to be placed on a separate panel of "Senior Judges NOT AVAILABLE until further notice", this is to save shows phoning judges who are too busy for a period, to save them the inconvenience of continuously having to refuse. May return to the Panel of Judges whenever they wish.
2. a ANY Show, excluding Regional Championships may use one judge only regardless of the number of horses, (May still use three if so desire.)  
b One Judge and one Steward is optional except Regional Championships MUST have three Judges.
3. Whenever invited, S.A. Championships must have two, but preferably three American Judges. RHJA felt it could not be compulsory. The Northern Sub Union said they had the finances and would be responsible for all costs. Put to the vote and was PASSED that providing all costs were paid by the Sub Union, U.S.A. Judges will be used at the '88 S.A. Champs.  
b Whenever we use an American judge he/she MUST have a Capital R rating. PASSED UNANIMOUSLY at both AGMs.
4. a All rated Saddle Horse Shows to use a "separate" Equitation Judge. It does not mean there has to be an additional judge - if there are three judges, one MUST have an Equitation qualification, and then only that judge will be judging the Equitation classes from 1 January 1988.  
b There is now an additional column on the Judges' Panel and judges (already qualified) who are interested may obtain an additional rating as "EQUITATION JUDGES" by applying in writing to the Secretary of the RHJA.  
c Additional, more detailed examinations, such as this year, to qualify future "Equitation Judges".
5. **RE - RIDES**  
All large classes where a re-ride is called for, the judges to pull out at least two more horses than the number to be placed, the other horses may be excused,
6. **CONSTITUTIONAL CHANGE; JUNIOR JUDGE TO OBTAIN SENIORITY 21 YEARS AND OLDER**  
Rule Book pages 333 & 334 No.6 JUNIOR JUDGES & No.4 SENIOR JUDGES.  
Junior Judges, who have passed the standard examinations, shall be placed a roster of Junior Judges, pending their promotion to Senior Judges after having completed judging a specified number of shows with different Seniors, and having received favourable reports. The number of shows to be judged is variable according to the ability of each Junior, and will be specified by the council.  
A Junior Judge may now obtain Seniority at 21 yrs & over; abiding by all the above regulations; instead of 25 & older.
7. **JUVENILE JUDGES**  
As Junior Judges have to be 21 years of age before they can be placed on the Roster; to encourage the youth, when they have passed all the required exams, will be placed on a separate "PANEL OF JUVENILE JUDGES" (Under 21 years of age.)

**B NEW RULES**

1. All Senior Judges who request self to be placed on a separate panel of "Senior Judges NOT AVAILABLE until further notice", this is to save shows phoning judges who are too busy for a period, to save them the inconvenience of continuously having to refuse, May return to the Panel of Judges whenever they wish.
- 2.a ANY Show, excluding Regional Championships may use one judge only regardless of the number of horses, (May still use three if so desire.)  
b One Judge and one Steward is optional except Regional Championships MUST have three Judges,
- 3 Whenever invited, S.A. Championships must have two, but preferably three American Judges. RHJA felt it could not be compulsory. The Northern Sub Union said they had the finances and would be responsible for all costs, Put to the vote and was PASSED that providing all costs were paid by the Sub Union, U.S.A. Judges will be used at the '88 S.A. Champs.
- b Whenever we use an American judge he/she MUST have a Capital R rating, PASSED UNANIMOUSLY at both AGMs.
- 4 a All rated Saddle Horse Shows to use a "separate" Equitation Judge. It does not mean there has to be an additional judge - if there are three judges, one MUST have an Equitation qualification, and then only that judge will be judging the Equitation classes from 1 January 1988,  
b There is now an additional column on the Judges' Panel and judges (already qualified) who are interested may obtain an additional rating as "EQUITATION JUDGES" by applying in writing to the Secretary of the RHJA.  
c Additional, more detailed examinations, such as this year, to qualify future "Equitation Judges".
- 5 **RE - RIDES**  
All large classes where a re-ride is called for, the judges to pull out at least two more horses than the number to be placed, the other horses may be excused,
- 6 **CONSTITUTIONAL CHANGE: JUNIOR JUDGE TO OBTAIN SENIORITY 21 YEARS AND OLDER**  
Rule Book pages 333 & 334 No.6 JUNIOR JUDGES & No.4 SENIOR JUDGES,  
Junior Judges, who have passed the standard examinations, shall be placed a roster of Junior Judges, pending their promotion to Senior Judges after having completed judging a specified number of shows with different Seniors, and having received favourable reports. The number of shows to be judged is variable according to the ability of each Junior, and will be specified by the council.  
A Junior Judge may now obtain Seniority at 21 yrs & over; abiding by all the above regulations; instead of 25 & older.
- 7 **JUVENILE JUDGES**  
As Junior Judges have to be 21 years of age before they can be placed on the Roster; to encourage the youth, when they have passed all the required exams, will be placed on a separate "PANEL OF JUVENILE JUDGES" (Under 21 years of age.)
