
CHOOSING THE CORRECT DISPENSER PUMP

HOW DO I CHOOSE THE CORRECT PUMP FOR MY DISPENSER ?

When buying a sanitiser/soap dispenser did you even know that you have a choice of pumps for different consumables?

It is vitally important to make sure you have the right pump for the job required.

When buying a sanitiser dispenser first you must consider which consumable you will be using.

Spray pump



Most alcohol based sanitiser tends to be thin and watery in consistency and works best when used with a spray pump. This pump will spray a small amount of product evenly into the palm of the hand for easy application.

Liquid pump



Ideal for most pearlised soaps, the liquid pump is ideal for use with sanitiser gels as it copes better with the thicker consistency placing a blob of sanitiser gel in the palm of the hand.

Foam pump



This pump is exclusively to be used for foam formulated soaps and sanitisers. The unique feature of these pumps is to inject air into the consumable allowing the formula to foam which will expand in the palm of the hand.
