Psalm 37:1-22 ESV

- 37 Fret not thyself because of evildoers, neither be thou envious against the workers of iniquity.
- ² For they shall soon be cut down like the grass, and wither as the green herb.
- ³Trust in the LORD, and do good; so shalt thou dwell in the land, and verily thou shalt be fed.
- ⁴Delight thyself also in the LORD: and he shall give thee the desires of thine heart.

- ¹⁰ For yet a little while, and the wicked shall not be: yea, thou shalt diligently consider his place, and it shall not be.
- ¹¹But the meek shall inherit the earth; and shall delight themselves in the abundance of peace.
- ¹²The wicked plotteth against the just, and gnasheth upon him with his teeth.
- ¹³The LORD shall laugh at him: for he seeth that his day is coming.
- ¹⁴The wicked have drawn out the sword, and have bent their bow, to cast down the poor and needy, and to slay such as be of upright conversation.
- 15 Their sword shall enter into their own heart, and their bows shall be broken.
- ¹⁶ A little that a righteous man hath is better than the riches of many wicked.
- ¹⁷ For the arms of the wicked shall be broken; but the LORD upholdeth the righteous.
- ¹⁸The LORD knoweth the days of the upright: and their inheritance shall be for ever.
- ¹⁹They shall not be ashamed in the evil time: and in the days of famine they shall be satisfied.
- ²⁰ But the wicked shall perish, and the enemies of the LORD shall be as the fat of lambs: they shall consume; into smoke shall they consume away.
- ²¹The wicked borroweth, and payeth not again: but the righteous sheweth mercy, and giveth.
- ²² For such as be blessed of him shall inherit the earth; and they that be cursed of him shall be cut off.
