Following up on "the world has gone after Him," John tells us some Greeks approached Philip

Are you that guy, that girl, like Andrew? Remember though, if you want that, you must die.

The Court of the Gentiles.....

WE WOULD SEE JESUS is everything.

The hour has come meant Jesus had to \_\_\_\_\_.

To the disciples, the hour has come meant.....

But to Jesus it meant....

His hour had come meant imminent death by the cross. It meant his ultimate glorification would come through.....His death meant much fruit.

Vs 25 is like those mentioned at the first. There are three refs to LIFE in this verse. The first two are the Greek word psuche, implying a worldly way of thinking, physical life, things perishable. The last word LIFE refers to the divine life inside of followers of Jesus Christ.

LOVE/HATE the contrast here is talking \_\_\_\_\_

Vs 26 Preferring Christ is to love, serve and follow Him and that might include suffering and even death. Jesus **never** cheapened His gospel call to an empty faith without following nor did He bribe anyone by promising health and wealth

Richard Phillips: "Much of our problem is that we do not aim high enough in life. We settle for earthly happiness when Christ calls for holiness. We settle for earthly success when we were made for heavenly glory."

Denying yourself and following Him is what Christianity is to look like.
