

John 14:7-11 A very common plea....

Jesus masterfully navigated this discussion to lead them to this thought:

On Monday of this week all of Jerusalem was crying “Hosanna” by Thursday Jesus was having his last moments with his disciples. John 13-17 all occurred on that Thursday night.

Jesus clearly told them, and us, who He was and is but they were not clear about who He was.

“Lord, show us the Father and it is enough.”

The Greek words for SEEING:

βλεπο Blepo -the most basic word for simply seeing as in a physical object:

θεωρο Theoreo – We get our word theory or theorize from this word. It has the thought of amazement or wonder in it.

οραω Horao – This word means to see with comprehension.

δεικνυμι Deiknumi – It mean to show in the sense of a demonstration.

How disappointed Jesus must have been...

Do visions/voices/signs/wonders help?

What Jesus was doing here was, once again, proclaiming his Deity...
