Vs 57 YAHWEH IS MY _____.

Upon following Christ, He becomes our portion and we become His. He is our sufficiency. II Peter 1:3 and Eph 1:13-14. Along with Him being our portion, we give Him a _____ to keep his Words.

Vs 58 Understanding He is our portion will necessarily lead us to _____. We will desire to seek his face, his presence through right worship. Our prayer includes asking for his MERCY.

Vs 59 has been described as the turning point of a man/woman's character and destiny. When we think seriously about Him and our relationship to his Word, our feet will necessarily follow our thoughts.

This passage gives us evidences of faith...

Vs 60 The Psalmist reminds us here that, once we are aware of Scripture's truth, as followers of Christ we must make haste to keep his commandments.

Vs 61 reveals that even as we are obedient, there are times when wickedness surrounds us. The real question becomes what do we think about in those times?

Vs 62 The psalmist is quick to praise Yahweh, to show gratitude to Him regardless of the circumstances or time.

Vs 63 gives us yet another evidence of whether we are in the faith or not....I am a companion of all those who fear you and those who keep your Word. A genuine love for Yahweh will result in a genuine love for His people.

Vs 64 There is _____ exile from the mercy of God. The earth is full of his lovingkindness.

Those who don't care to be instructed by the Word have never resolved to be holy. Those who have resolved to be holy are most eager to be taught.
