

Weekly Sermon Reflection

"He Is Risen... And So Are We"

When the women came to the tomb that morning, they didn't find what they expected. The stone was rolled away, the body was gone—and when they told the others, it sounded like nonsense. Too wild, too impossible to believe.

And honestly, we get it. Even today, the resurrection can seem distant—like a beautiful metaphor or an old legend we nod along to. But the truth is deeper. The resurrection is real. Jesus Christ truly, physically rose from the dead. And if that's true... it changes everything.

It means that death has been defeated—not just for Him, but for us too. It means our past mistakes, our guilt, our fears, don't own us anymore. It means that hope is not some fragile feeling—it's a fact, built on the blood and victory of the living Son of God.

Believing in the resurrection isn't just about agreeing with a story; it's about stepping into a whole new way of living. It's about walking every day knowing you are free, forgiven, and alive with a purpose that death can't touch. It's about letting the truth of the empty tomb shake your soul awake —reminding you that no chain is stronger than His love, no darkness is greater than His light.

If Christ is alive, then so are we. If He conquered the grave, then there is nothing too broken, too far gone, or too hopeless for Him to heal.

This is the foundation of our faith. Not wishful thinking—but a living, breathing hope that storms the gates of darkness and shouts, "He is not here; He has risen!"

The resurrection means we don't fight for victory—we fight from victory.

We live not as people trying to survive but as people who have already overcome through Him.

This is why we celebrate. This is why we live differently. Because the King has come... and death could not hold Him.

Sydel's Daily Devotion Living Out The Resurrection

(Colossians 3:1, Philippians 1:21, 2 Corinthians 4:7, Exodus 15:2)

The resurrection isn't just something we celebrate once a year—it's the reality we're called to live every day. Because Jesus rose from the dead, our lives are meant to look different. Colossians 3:1 reminds us, "If then you have been raised with Christ, seek the things that are above." We aren't chained to the old ways anymore. Our minds, our hearts, and our actions are called higher—to reflect the life we now have in Him.

For us, to live is Christ and to die is gain (Philippians 1:21). This isn't about living safely or blending in. It's about living boldly, knowing that our real life is hidden with Christ, and nothing this world can offer compares. We carry this treasure—this new life, this hope—in jars of clay (2 Corinthians 4:7), fragile and imperfect, but filled with the unstoppable power of God. His strength shines brightest through our weakness.

And just like Exodus 15:2 declares, "The LORD is my strength and my song, and he has become my salvation," we are not walking this journey alone. The same God who split the seas for His people is the same God who raises dead things to life in us today. Living out the resurrection means choosing daily to believe that victory is already ours. It's not about pretending life is easy—it's about standing firm even when it's not. It's about letting His Spirit transform how we see, how we love, and how we fight.

We are living proof that the grave is empty.

We are the light in a world still stumbling in the dark.

We are the song of the risen King.
