Equipping Leaders Through Timothy Leadership Training

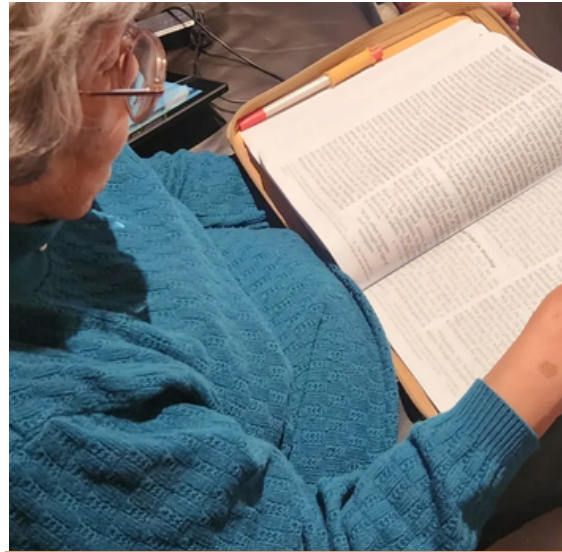
