Oppose the infilling of Bridge 2062 at Braughing station

We, the undersigned, wish to register our objection to the intention of National Highways to infill beneath Bridge 2062 at Braughing Station, Hertfordshire.

Bridge 2062 is among the last surviving structural elements of the former Buntingford branch line. Together with the station buildings, platforms, goods shed, platelayers' hut and signal box, it forms a coherent group of historic railway assets whose character depends on the open space beneath it. Infilling would permanently close off that open space, destroying the relationship between the surviving structures and fundamentally altering the character and heritage value of the site.

We call on National Highways to reconsider its plan, and to give full and proper weight to the heritage significance of this structure alongside engineering and cost considerations. We do not accept that infilling represents the only viable solution, and we urge that a proportionate repair option – one that addresses the structural concerns whilst retaining the open space beneath the bridge – be developed, costed and given fair consideration before any planning application is made.
