VIRTUAL MISSION QUILT SHOW

Due to current events the Mission Quilt Show will be virtual. The Virtual Quilt Show will be posted on our website from Jan. 18th – Jan. 29th, 2021. Everyone can access the virtual exhibit by visiting our website at www.missionmuseum.org. Because the 15th Annual Quilt Show will be virtual there will only be three awards: Viewers' Choice winners (1st, 2nd, and 3rd). Viewers are encouraged to vote by emailing their quilt of choice to missionmuseum@gmail.com. Voting will begin Jan. 18th, 2021 and will end on Feb. 5th, 2021. Only one vote is allowed per email. Winners will be contacted by February 9th, 2021. Viewers' Choice 1st place will receive a Mission Historical Museum Gift Basket

REGISTRATION INFORMATION

- **The deadline to register is January 8th, 2021 @ 4pm.**
- Entry forms must be completed upon submission
- **DO NOT FORGET TO SUBMIT TWO PHOTOS OF YOUR QUILT ALONG WITH YOUR ENTRY FORM.** The first photo will need to be a full view photo. The second will need to be a detailed photo of the quilt design.
- All entry forms and photos must be submitted via email to missionmuseum@gmail.com, please type Quilt Entry and your full name in the subject line.

For example: "Quilt Entry – (full name here)"

- You will receive a confirmation email once you have been successfully registered.

PHOTOGRAPHING YOUR QUILT

- Required Photos for Quilt Gallery
Two photos are required, one full view and one detailed view. If the back of your quilt is unique, you may include a third photo. Each full view photo should have sufficient border around the quilt to allow editing for the virtual show.
- Taking Photos of Your Quilt
We recommend using your camera or phone on the highest resolution setting and saving as a JPEG, JPG or PNG, file. A full view means no folded corners, no items in front of the quilt, and no fingers peeking over the top. For the best results, suspend your quilt from a curtain rod, letting it hang freely. Shoot your quilt at a 90° angle from the CENTER of the quilt. If you shoot your quilt from above or below, the quilt will not appear square. Make sure the entire quilt is visible in the full shot. Lighting should be as even as possible across the front of the quilt. Make sure your camera is focused. If your hand is shaky, use a tripod or a solid surface for the camera. When selecting your detail shot, choose a 12-inch section of your quilt that is your favorite. Show your best work in your detailed shot. Make sure you are not physically too close to your quilt when taking the picture, as your camera may have trouble focusing.
- Do not Edit or Crop Your Photos
Please do not edit your photos. They will be edited if needed for the virtual show.
