Prepare to Pray

1. Examine Yourself Spiritually.

The first and most important step in preparation for your prayer walk is a thorough spiritual self-examination that identifies specific areas of sin that need to be confessed. (This may be things you are doing or attitudes you have that are contrary to God's law and plan for your life, OR things you should be doing that you are neglecting to do.) This turning of our hearts and lifestyles back to God in genuine repentance and worship will result in personal revival through restored communion with God, ensuring that our prayers are heard. (John 9:31).

2. Minimize Distractions.

Next, set your phone to silent mode in order to prevent any unnecessary interruptions or distractions.

3. Focus Your Mind.

Finally, clear your mind of any other thoughts and priorities that would prevent God from having your full attention. He is a jealous God and wants your full attention!
